### CHICAGO STORE LETS CONTRACT FOR EXPANSION

The contract has been let for the extension of the Oregon Shoe store to the alley, and as soon as it is fitted up the Chicago Store will be extended over into that large room and will occupy two floors of the double store on the old Dalrymple corner. The remarkable record of McEvoy Brothers, who opened business less than seven years ago in a mere handbox at the rear of the White Corner, until now they have forty-two departments and thirty-two employes, remains unbroken in the Capital City or the Pacific northwest, and is a high testimonial to the resources of these gentlemen and to the wealth and productiveness of the Willamette valley. Their aim is to have the largest daylight store between Portland and San Francisco and they will have accomplished a long stride in this direction when they are fully installed in their new additional quarters some time in March.

He has in the past year spent \$3000 on new buildings, and added machinery until he has now the largest and most complete plant of the kind in the city, or in this portion of the state. He is putting in two elevators and a suite of offices for accounting and draughting, on Church street. The whole plant is steam heated. A new boiler room and lumber sheds have been added, as well as a large veneering room. Among other machinery a new style large sand-papering machine has been added, which finishes doors and windows and all inside work so perfectly that it goes out of the shop ready for the painter's brush, at a cost of \$1500. The finest paneled and veneered oak and other hardwood doors are made at this shop, which employs from twenty to thirty hands and has a payroll of from \$300 to \$400 per week. Mr. Hansen is a progressive and public spirited citizen, who believes in keeping fully abreast of the times. He has begun building new sidewalks on both sides of his plant without waiting to be ordered to do so by the city authorities, thus setting a good example to the rest of the community.

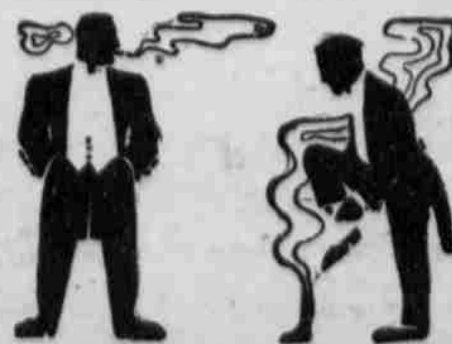
