Supreme Court Decisions.
 A decision was handed down by the supreme court this morning in the case of Anna C. Hough and Marion county against S. A. D. Puter, which covered 65 pages of legal cap paper and covers 73 points in law. This is a suit in equity involving the rights to the waters of Silver creek, Lake county, Ore. The suit was begun in 1900 to enjoin the diversion of the waters of the stream in question. The decision of Commissioner King modifies the decision in the courts below. This is the most complicated decision ever handed down by the supreme court of the state.

The court also gave its decision on the L. Zimmerman vs. C. C. Grizmacher as reversed and remanded. This was a proceeding brought against Zimmerman by C. C. Grizmacher, representing the municipal court of Portland, on information charging him with operating and maintaining a slaughter house within the city limits not in accordance with the laws of the city.
