

WOULD PAY \$25,000 FOR FRANK CHANCE

(United Press Leased Wire.)
Los Angeles, Jan. 7.—The strongest bid yet made by the outlaw state leaguers for a player from the ranks of organized baseball, is an offer of \$25,000 for two seasons to Frank Chance, the famous first baseman and manager of the Chicago Nationals, according to a report here today.

The attractive offer was made by Danny Shay, representing a committee of Stockton business men.

Chance said in reply that he could not give a definite answer until he had communicated with President Murphy of the Chicago club. Chance has been drawing a pretty big salary from the Cub management besides owning shares in the stock of the club for which he has refused \$40,000.

Chance is known to have asked more than Murphy had expressed himself as willing to pay, but it is possible that he will accede to his first baseman's demand rather than lose for Chicago her great baseball idol.

NAT GOODWIN SHOWS HIMSELF A SCRUB

San Francisco, Jan. 7.—Nat Goodwin and his bride, formerly Edna Goodrich, the actress, are in this city today en route to Long Beach.

Goodwin said that Booth Tarkington's "Cameo Kirby" was a great play, but that it needed overhauling. He declared that, in its present shape he was afraid to take it into New York, but that he would reappear in it, and that Mrs. Goodwin would be his leading lady.

Goodwin declared that he had compromised his mining troubles in Nevada, and, in commenting on the arrest of Harry MacMillan, on a charge of passing fictitious checks, said of his former rival for the hand of Miss Goodrich:

"I am not surprised. He is a pinhead, a lightweight and a four-flasher. I had his number before the cards were out of the case box. He has no class."
