

REYNOLDS SAYS BILL WILL HIT PRUNE DRIERS

AIMED AT PAPER MILLS WHERE MAGAINES MAKE \$100 AN HOUR

Monday was Labor Day in the foot in the grave." Reynolds asked if it would apply to men working in prune driers. Campbell said it would. It was a bill hitting at the paper mills where machines now run 24 hours at a stretch and earn \$100 an hour.

Reynolds made the point that prune driers had to run for about 50 days, day and night, and had a hard time to get hands to work on two shifts. It would be impossible to get hands enough to run prune driers on three shifts. The bill passed just the same.

Governor's Message.

A message was read in the house calling attention to the decision of the supreme court in the Yamhill county case, setting aside tax levies for state purposes for the year 1909, and the same was referred to committee on assessment and taxation. Governor Chamberlain says no serious difficulty will be experienced in making a tax levy by the legislature that will be legal, and will validate all tax enactments required this year. Hon. F. W. Mukey, of the state tax commission is here to help frame up a remedial act.

Local Option Amendment.

Representative Bonebrake, of Benton, introduced a bill today making it a misdemeanor for a witness to refuse to testify in a liquor case. It is an amendment to the local option law, to make its enforcement possible in billed pig prosecutions in dry counties.

ALL ABOUT FUMES FROM THE SMELTERS

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Helena, Mont., Jan. 26.—Following the decision given yesterday in favor of the Amalgamated Copper Company, preparations are being made today to investigate with a view of ascertaining if the discharge of arsenic from the Anaconda smelter cannot be reduced. For some time farmers have been in litigation in an effort to have the Washoe smelter, at Anaconda, closed, claiming the smoke and gases from it destroyed vegetation and almost killed livestock. Judge W. H. Hunt, of the United States district court, decided that the smelter should not be shut down, but that an investigation concerning the arsenic coming from it should be made.

PROPERTY IS HELD FOR THE ASSESSMENTS

CITY NOT LIABLE IN SOUTH COMMERCIAL STREET IMPROVEMENT

In the suit of Peter Rubin and John Feldman, plaintiffs, vs. City of Salem and W. D. Gibson, defendants, Judge Galloway today handed down the following opinion:

"Plaintiffs are owners of property abutting on South Commercial street in the city of Salem, and ask that the assessment upon their property made by the defendant city for the improvement of said street be set aside, and declared null and void, alleging that the improvements made and accepted by the city were not in compliance with the advertised notices and specifications and regulations in the ordinance authorizing the improvement on said street.

"Plaintiffs further allege that, under the city charter, a failure on the part of the city to strictly comply with conditions in the published notice and the specifications set out in the ordinance authorizing the proposed improvements deprives the city of jurisdiction, and that all subsequent proceedings for the proposed improvement will be void and inoperative to its use and benefit, and that the city is liable for the cost of the improvements, and request for judgment and authority to ascertain their ownership.

"On the other hand, counsel for the defendant city asks that when improvements have been accepted by the proper authorities, and there is such acceptance as conclusive evidence that the work was performed according to the requirements of the preliminary notice, plans, specifications and contract. They also cite numerous decisions to support their contention.

"It is of the opinion that the city would be responsible to the contractor after acceptance and approval of the work, and the plaintiffs should prevent any complication. Sold by all dealers.
