

#### STRAUS CLAIMS JAPS ARE LEAVING AMERICA

[Un.ted Press Leased Wire.] Washington, Jan. 29.—Denials of ecent representations that the tide of Japanese immigration is increasing, instead of diminishing, are contained in a letter on its way today to Senator Frank P. Flint, of California, from Secretary Straus, of commerce and labor.

Secretary Straus said in part:

'You will observe that the number of Japanese admitted was 1.2, 413 for the calendar year 1907, while the entire number admitted was but 4477 for the calendar year 1908. You will also bear in mnd that the executive order of the President was issued on March 14, 1907, but it took a considerable time to prepare regulations provided for in that order, and put the regulations into effect, and for the department of state, both here and through our ambassador to Japan, to arrive at a definite understanding wth the Japanese government. I desire furthermore to direct your attention to the fact that the entire immigration for the year beginning with November 1, 1907, and ending with October 3 1908, was 6017, while the departures for the same period was 5832, leaving an increase for immigration of Japanese for that year of 185.

"It is further to be observed that, beginning with the month of June, 1908, to October, 1908, the emigration of Japanese from the United States exceeded the immigration to the United States by 1542, showing distnctly that the trend of the emigration of Japanese is from the tion during the months referred .o of 1908, as compared with the same months of 1907.

"It has further been intimated, as I see from reports, that there is a large surreptitious influx of Japan as over the Mexican and Canadian borders. I am justified in saying that is not true, for obvious reasons. That there are some few scattering surr 'ptitious entries is quite probable, but the sum is so small that it cannot be consequential.

"Finally, I wish to call your att a tion to the fact which the statements above referred to indicate, that the arrangements which have been called 'The Gentleman's agreemnt' we have with Japan, in my judgment, is work- Eggs ing more effectively than would result from any other restriction law, because of the effective embargo Japan has placed upon the departure of her subjects from Japan."
