TACOMA FIREMAN KILLED IN COLLISION

Tacoma, Wash., Jan. 30.—Injured in a collision between a Spanaway electric car and a hose wagon, Fireman Daniel Noonan is dead today, and J. W. Taylor, relief driver of the wagon is painfully but not seriously injured. The accident occurred last night while the firemen were responding to an alarm of fire. The hose wagon, followed by the engine and hook and ladder truck, was running at full speed. The driver did not see the approaching car until it was too late to stop.

The injured fireman was removed to the Paddock hospital, where, early this morning, Noonan succumbed to his injuries.

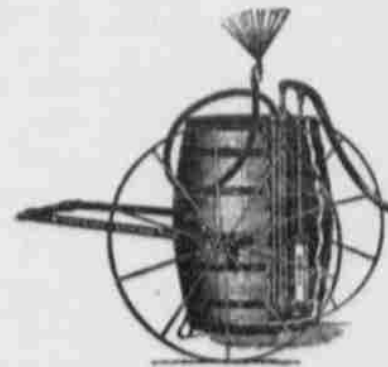

Some Figures for Farmers Who Have Land That Ought To Be Cleared

Every good farmer with uncleared land ought to clear up at least 10 acres a year. Say such a farmer starts this year, it will be about like this:

Cost of a stump puller \$100
For clearing the land 200
For plowing, etc 100

Total \$400
