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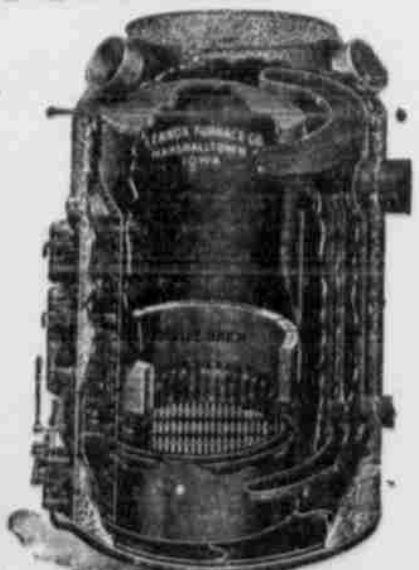
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The above cut represents our brick lined Torrid Zone Furnace. Guaranteed gas, smoke and dust proof. Economical and durable.

BILLS, RESOLUTIONS AND DOINGS IN GENERAL BY THE SOLONS

Senate—Tuesday Morning.
Called to order at 10 o'clock with 26 senators present. Rev. Babcock, of Salem, offered prayer. The judiciary committee reporting on Senator Kellaher's bill relating to recovery of damages for accident causing death, (S. B. 137) recommended that it do not pass and it was indefinitely postponed by a vote of 19 to 9. House Bill 4, limiting the hours of work was indefinitely postponed without opposition. The House resolution to raise salary of the members of the legislature to \$6 per day was indefinitely postponed by a vote of 23 to 5.

Third Reading of Bills.
S. B. 37, Cole, to require medical certificate as requisite to issuance of marriage license. Passed, 28 voting for, with two absent.
S. B. 105, Albee, to define vagrancy and disorderly conduct. Referred.
S. B. 123, Parrish, to raise salary of treasurer of Harney county. A motion to refer back to committee with instructions to amend bill so that salary will not take effect during present incumbent; lost by a vote of 21 to 8. A motion to refer the matter to people of Harney county was also lost by a vote of 24 to 5. Passed by a vote of 22 to 7.
