**HEADLIGHTS ON THE TROLLEY CARS**

The Railroad Commission received an answer today from the Oregon Electric Railway Company, in answer to the communication sent the company by the commission relative to headlights on the cars running between this city and Portland. The Railroad Commission made inquiry a few days ago as to why the company did not provide some means to prevent the headlight from going out when the trolley left the wire, and in reply the railway people stated that it would require a monster dry battery system to keep these large headlights going at intervals when the trolley left the wire, and no such system was used, to their knowledge, on any other electric line in the United States. The letter said the cars were supposed to come to an immediate standstill when the trolley jumped the wire, and the motorman who failed to comply with this regular rule of the company was not acting in accordance with instructions. However, the company claims that the trolley can be replaced within 20 seconds, which barely gives a car time to come to a standstill. Lanterns are provided to be used by the trainmen on these occasions, also. In conclusion the letter stated the company was installing an improved phantograph, which has a roller contact with the wire, and if this new device does its work as expected, there will be no more jumping of trolleys.
