PROGRAM FOR ATHLETIC WORK

The committee appointed by the last meeting of the teachers' institute to arrange a program for the Marion County Athletic Union have made a report to County School Superintendent Smith, and the following list of events are now being mailed out to the different districts composing the union:

Baseball—Entrance fee (teams) \$1.00. All teams wishing to enter the league will notify a member of the baseball committee. If you are north of Salem notify W. C. Ganutr, Hubbard. If south of Salem notify W. H. Martin, Jefferson. Entrance fee payable when you make application to join the league.

Relay race—half mile, team of six. Entrance 50c per team, boys under high school.

Tug of war—Team of five, fee 50c per team. Girls under high school.

Track events—Entrance fee to each individual event will be 25c. These events are free for all. Score will be, first place 5 points; second, 3 points; third, 1 point.
