KING JAMES' DENUNCIATION OF TOBACCO AND ITS SEQUEL

Within two centuries after the discovery of tobacco, the Indian and American in 1492, tobacco had conquered the world.

Perhaps none of its opponents have been more bitterly antagonistic than those of the fifteenth century, when it was struggling for a foothold in the Old World.

Tobacco is the lively image and pattern of hell, for it has by illusion in it all the parts and vices of the world, whereby hell may be gained, to-wit:

"First, it is a smoke; so are the vanities of this world.

"Second, it delights them who take it; so do the pleasures of the world describe the men of the world.
