**LENT AS KEPT BY GOOD CATHOLICS**  
 Lenten services were begun at St. Joseph's Catholic church Wednesday morning with the blessing and distribution of ashes, symbolic of penance. During the Lenten period, which covers forty days, mass will be held daily in the church except Saturday, when it will be held in the convent; on Wednesday of each week will be held the rosary and the benediction, and on each Friday the services in commemoration of the way to the cross.

Following the the laws which the faithful are obliged by conscience to observe:  
 All obliged to fast are allowed flesh meats three times on Sunday, once a day on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, excepting Saturdays of the Ember days and Holy week.  
 The use of fish, milk, butter and eggs is permitted on all days of Lent at the evening collation, and the principal meals on those days on which the use of flesh meats is forbidden.

In the morning a small piece of bread is allowed with a cup of coffee, tea or chocolate or some similar drink.  
 When the principal meal cannot be taken before noon, the order may be inverted and the collation taken in the morning and the dinner in the evening.

Lard or grease may be used in preparing the lawful victuals.  
 Those of the faith who are exempt from the obligation of fasting can, on the days when the use of flesh meats is permitted to all of the faithful be allowed to use it several times a day, as on Sundays of Lent, when the obligation is not binding. The use of both flesh meat and fish together at the same meal is strictly forbidden during the whole of Lent.

By virtue of the Indult, granted for ten years by the Holy See, to the bishops of the United States, working men and their families are allowed the use of flesh meat on all the fast and abstinence days throughout the year, with the exception of all Fridays, Ash Wednesdays, the Wednesday and Saturday of Holy week and the Vigil of Christmas. Those who avail themselves of this dispensation are not allowed to eat fish and meat at the same meal and they are exorted to perform some other acts of modification and penance, in accord with the spirit of the holy season of Lent. A most useful and commendable custom is that of abstaining during Lent from stimulants in honor of the Sacred Thirst of our Divine Lord.

Those who are excused from fasting on account of age or hard labor, may use flesh meat more than once on the days on which it is allowed.  
 Members of the church under 21 and over 60 years of age are exempt from these rules, as are also those compelled to do hard manual or taxing mental labor, and those whose weak physical condition demands the more nourishing food. All are charged to avoid all public entertainment and social pleasures and intoxicating beverages, and no marriage ceremonies are performed until the first Sunday after Easter.

 As they walked up the street, McGinn punched Gearin in the ribs with his elbow as one of the men behind remarked: "That Johnny Gearin is the d—st liar on earth," and Gearin just gave McGinn one of those far-away looks of his, as the other fellow said: "That right, sure he is, barrin' Henry McGinn."
