| United Press Leased Wire.] | New York, March 16.—Commentng on his defeat by Dorando Pietri in the Marathon race last night gr Madison Square Garden, John D Hayes, winner of the Olympic marathon distance race in England, said

"The next time I will run my own race, not Dorando's. My condition was good at the start but the clip was too fast for me. Had I fellowed my own judgment I believe a different story of the result would be told."

It was learned today that Hayes ran a race which had been set for him by his trainers according to a prearranged schedule. Hayes was defeated before a crowd of 10,000 persons, a great number being admirers of Dorando. The course was over the regular distance of 26 miles 285 yards, 10 laps to the mile. Dorando won by half a mile in 2 hours. 48 minutes, 8 seconds.
