Los Angeles, March 20.—Madame Helena Modjeska's condition is unchanged today, according to a statement given the United Press by her physician, Dr. J. E. Boyd, of Santa Ana.

The famous actress is believed to be dying, and there is little hope that she will be able to rally from her present condition. She is suffering from Bright's disease, which is augmented by heart trouble.

At Modjeska's home on Bay Island

near Newport, 40 miles south of here, optimistic reports are given out, but it is evident that every one there realizes the gravity of the patient's illness. It is reported that while it is possible that the actress may live for some time, there is imminent danger of her death and practically no hope for her ultimate recovery.

HAVE SO MUCH CAN NOT PAY THEIR TAXES

Chehalis, Wash., March 20.—Attorneys representing the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company, which probably owns in the United States more timber land than any other one concern, are said to be planning to contest the corporation's 1908 assessment in Lewis county.

The taxes aggregate \$122,000, which the company declares is excessive. However, \$32,881.71 of that amount has been paid on account. This sum only represents the assess-

ment on the cheapest timber controlled by the company, which has taken no action toward paying taxes on its more valuable property in the Pacific northwest.
