GREAT EDUCATIONAL RALLY IN POLK

MOUNTAIN VIEW SCHOOL WAS CROWDED FINE PROGRAM AND SPLENDID PICNIC DINNER SERVED--NEXT RALLY AT BUENA VISTA.

W. H. Brunk presided at the educational rally at Mountain View school house in Polk county Saturday. There was a large attendance, and a fine picnic dinner, with hot coffee, was served at the noon hour. The school house is a model in

many respects and was beautifully decorated for the occasion. First the school children sang America, Ethel Bennett accompanying on the piano. "Compulsory Education" was then quite thoroughly discussed. County Superintendent Seymour, C.

H. Chapman, L. Grice and A. Southwick taking part in the debate. Next "Union High Schools" was discussed by the same debaters and John Ferguson and others, several ladies taking part. The sentiment is growing very strong for the union high school idea.

The unit administration proposition is to put all the schools of a county under one board, who build all school houses, hire all teachers, make all repairs, and it was generally repudiated by the speakers present.

The unit of administration was next discussed, and both sides were fairly stated, but most of the speakers were against it.

At this point Miss Nellie Taylor announced that coffee was ready, and the dinner was served. It was a splendid repast.

Miss Eva Nash, who has taught the Mountain View school, is one of the hardest workers and most successful teachers in the county. She

opened the afternoon session with a song by the primary grades. "Happy Greetings." Their marching and singing was to perfect time and tune.

Recitation, "Jim McFee, of Tennessee," by Vesta Gardner.

"Our Motto" was sung by Mary Schindler, the words of Lincoln, "Never Say Fail."

There were some numbers on the phonograph, and then the discussion of "Elementary Agriculture" was taken up. There were speeches for and against, and the sentiment was strong for this study in the public schools.

Miss Taylor rather got the best of Mr. Chapman on the argument. County Superintendent Seymour showed that elementary agriculture was a substitute for reading classes, and without losing any time from other studies. The children were fond of this study, and preferred it to other studies. "Condition of School Buildings" was next discussed. Creation of a county high school fund was a warm subject, and was thoroughly threshed out.

Parents visiting schools, better attendance at the schools, janitor work, the county high school fund and other practical questions were introduced and debated by many of those present.

Miss Luce recited "The Goblins." The children all did remarkably well.

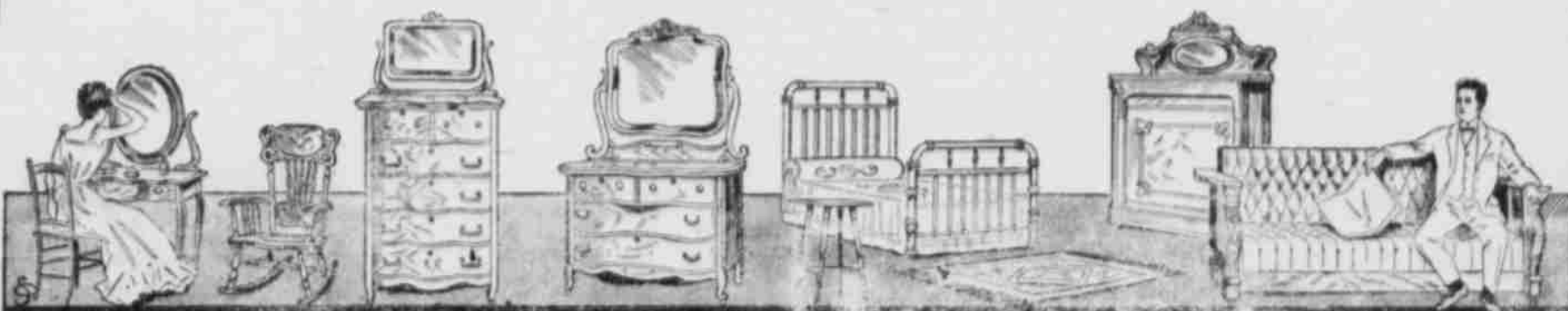
