



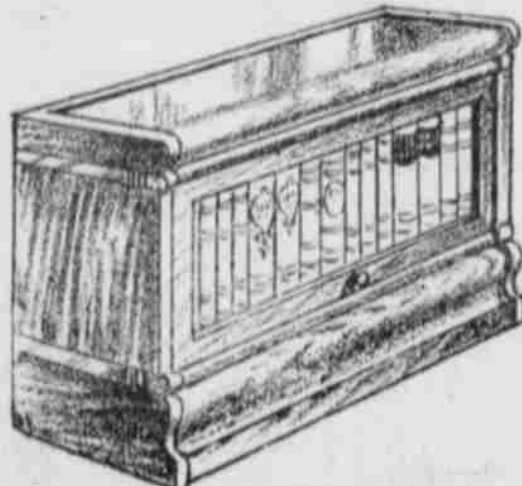

GOVERNMENT EXHIBITS ARRIVING AT SEATTLE

Seattle, Wash., March 23.—The first shipment of government exhibits for the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition has arrived at the fair grounds, and is being placed in the Fisheries building. In all there will be 75 carloads of exhibits from the federal government, and a great deal of the material is now on the way to Seattle.

The Fisheries building will contain many of the most interesting features of the government display. Big tanks having glass fronts have been placed about the building, and will be supplied from the salt and fresh water reservoirs below the floor. Particular attention will be given to displaying the fish found on the Pacific.

AGED WOMAN IS BURNED TO DEATH

Tacoma, Wash., March 23.—Parker Pearce is suffering from severe burns today, and his wife, Mrs. Mary E. Pearce, aged 79 years old, is dead, as the result of a fire which late last night destroyed the old county hospital building, and several adjoining buildings.

Mr. and Mrs. Pearce lived in the main building, which was a two-story shell, abandoned five years ago, upon completion of the new hospital.

The aged couple were about to retire last night, Mrs. Pearce overturned a kerosene lamp, the oil scattering about the room and bursting into flame. Pearce tried in vain to put out the fire, but finally was forced to flee from the room. By the time the firemen arrived the building was a roaring furnace and Mrs. Pearce's body was burned to a crisp.

EUGENE MAN COMMITTS SUICIDE

New York, March 23.—The funeral of Mark D. Rolfe, who committed suicide at the Grand Union Hotel here last week, was held today.

The body was identified last night by Eckols Rolfe, of Eugene, Ore., as that of his son who left home recently for a trip around the world. The body was cremated, and the ashes will be taken to Oregon.

F. J. HENEY AGAIN OBJECTS TO FULTON

Washington, March 23.—Another protest has been made to Attorney-General Wickersham by Francis J. Heney, the famous California graft prosecutor, against steps looking to the appointment of Charles W. Fulton, former United States senator from Oregon, to the federal bench.

The protest was handed to Mr. Wickersham by Tracey C. Becker, who is here making a strong fight against Fulton's appointment. Later he conferred with President Taft. When questioned today concerning the contents of the protest, Mr. Becker declined to discuss Prosecutor Heney's latest attack. He declined also to reveal the nature of his discussion with the President.

It is doubtful that the attorney-general will be able to lay the protest before the President today, as he will not be able to go through it immediately.

TELEGRAPHERS STRIKE IS OFF

Paris, March 23.—The strike of the telegraphers and postal employees was declared off this morning following a general meeting by the strikers. The employees will return to their old positions pending a settlement of their difficulties with the government.

WANTS DAMAGES FOR DEATH OF HUSBAND

Everett, Wn., March 23.—Charged with the responsibility of her husband's death, Mrs. Sallie Blah, who is an invalid at a Seattle hospital, has commenced action in the superior court to recover \$25,000 damages from William Dummock & Co., who conduct two saloons at Edmonds. In her complaint the woman alleges that the saloonmen sold her late husband the liquor with which he became intoxicated, and which caused him to commit suicide several weeks ago.

MINNESOTA MAN GETS ALASKA MARSHALSHIP

Washington, March 23.—Senator Nelson of Minnesota announced after conferring with President Taft today that Harvey Sullivan will be named as the new judicial district marshal for Alaska.

ANOTHER RAILROAD COMPLETED TO SEATTLE

Seattle, Wash., March 23.—The last gap in the Chicago, Milwaukee & Puget Sound railroad, between the portal of the St. Paul tunnel in the Bitter Root mountains and Puget Sound has been closed. The track layers drove the last spike at a point several miles east of the Columbia river bridge yesterday. This gives the Milwaukee a through line from the coast to the St. Paul tunnel. Only 25 miles now remain to be built to close up the line between Chicago and the Northwest. This last gap is in Bitter Root valley. The last spike in the transcontinental line will be driven, officials say, on April 2, as originally planned.

Ballasting of the line is progressing rapidly, and freight traffic will soon be going forward over the whole system.
