FRISCO WANTS TO ENTERTAIN JAPS

San Francisco, March 26.—"Instead of snubbing the Japanese, and refusing to participate in a meeting for the purpose of planning to entertain the Japanese merchants on the Pacific coast, the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce has taken the exactly opposite course," said Chester Burks, secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, in an interview today.

"We have never received from the north any invitation to attend a meeting at Portland for this purpose, and the news that we refused to attend such a gathering is the first news I have had on the subject."

The San Francisco Chamber of Commerce early this year adopted the suggestion of its committee on commercial relations with Japan, advising the entertainment of a party of Japanese merchants on this coast, as an act of reciprocity for the elaborate reception given the Chamber of Commerce's party in the Orient last year. The suggestion, says Secretary Burks, was laid before the associated Chambers of Commerce of the Pacific coast, and was heartily endorsed by that body, composed of representatives of the Spokane, Tacoma, Seattle, Portland, Los Angeles, Oakland, San Diego and San Francisco organizations.

The proposition, as elaborated, was to invite to this country, in the name of the Pacific coast, a large party of Japanese merchants and economic experts, to be conducted through all the Western states and entertained on a lavish scale. Fearful that they would not be able to return as richly the favors which the Japanese showered on the visiting Pacific coast merchants last year, it was deemed best to ask for a congressional appropriation of from \$75,000 to \$100,000 to help defray the expenses of this reception. Congress was not able to vote this money at this session, and the plan has been delayed, and the invitation with held until a later date.

CANNOT IDENTIFY HER AS HIS DAUGHTER

(United Press Leased Wire.)
Chicago, March 26.—Declaring that he was unable to state whether the woman arrested in connection with the kidnapping of Billie Whittle from Sharon, is his daughter, W. E. McDermott, a retired fireman, 62 years old, today threw an interesting sidelight on the career of a girl who may prove to be the woman charged with the Pennsylvania kidnapping.

McDermott declared that he had three daughters, one of them named Anna, who was reported to have married but whose married name or her whereabouts he did not know. He added that Anna had been educated at a convent at Madison, Wis. The Sharon suspect also had a convent education.

McDermott said that his daughter's actions after she returned from the convent became such that he ordered her to leave home. The girl did so and he heard nothing of her until a year ago, when she called him up by telephone and told him that she had married a man who had millions and was going to New York to live.

McDermott said that he hung up the telephone receiver while she was talking and has not heard of her since, until reports became current in connection with the Whittle case.

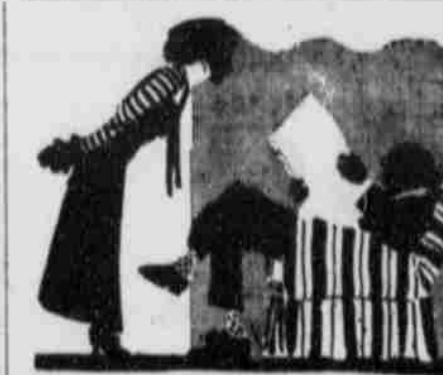
