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## THE DIMENSIONS OF A PORTLAND MAYOR.

A man of the all-around bigness to be mayor of Portland has not yet appeared in the lists of candidates.

A mayor of a city like Portland should be big enough to protect the humblest citizen, and to deal justly with the largest interest.

A great business corporation, dealing with the comforts of thousands of people and property worth hundreds of millions should employ a \$10,000 a year man at least.

## A BLIGHTING REGISTRATION LAW.

Portland newspapers complain that few voters are registering for the coming city election.

They blame the citizens for apathy, when they should the law for its **ALL-ROUND BLIGHTING INFLUENCE.**

He acknowledges no master, but the people, and himself as their prophet.

Normal schools mean that more mature men and women shall teach school, and fewer immature persons. 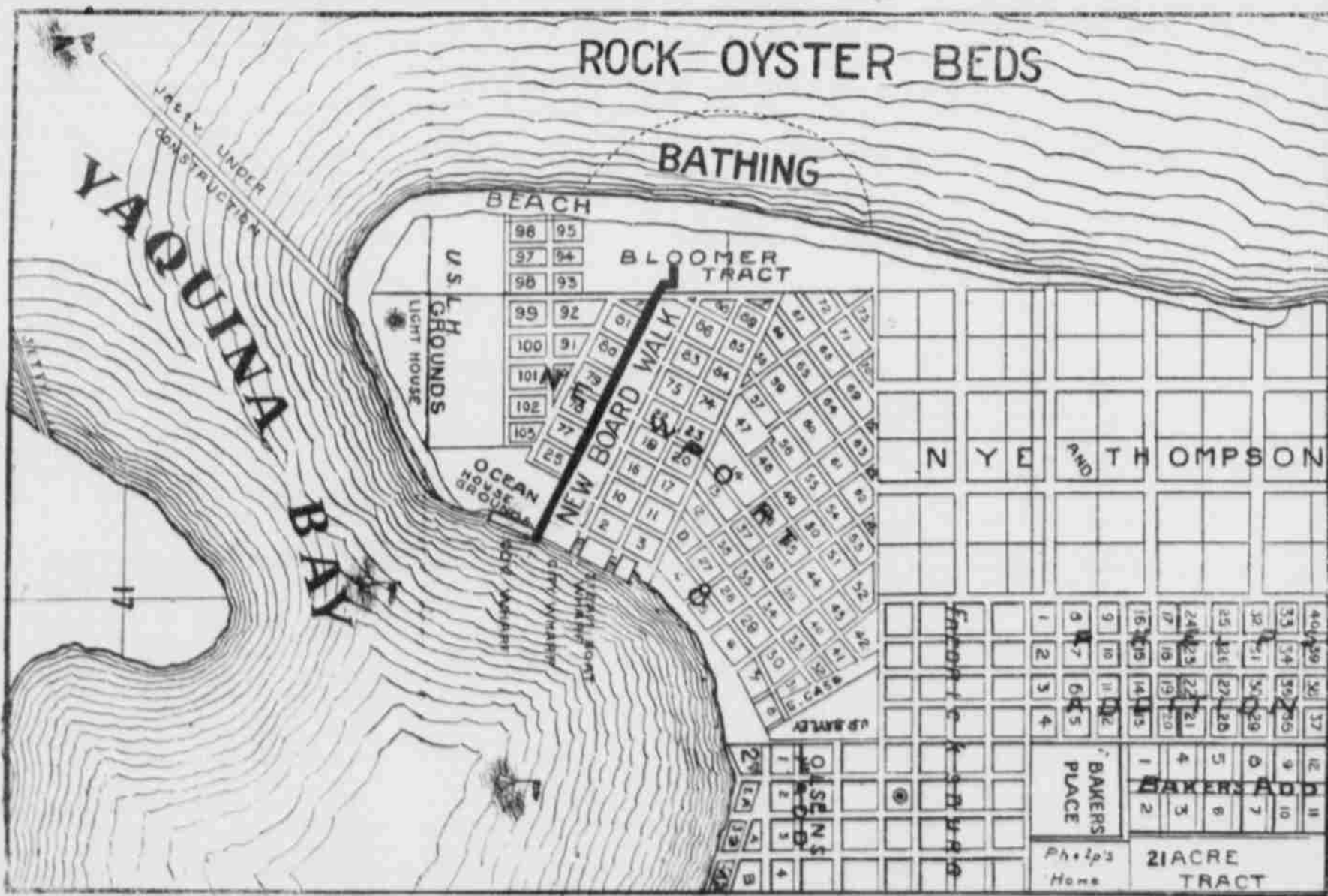
