WOULD ARBITRATE STATE LINES

(United Press Leased Wire.)
Portland, Or., March 31.—Governor M. E. Hay, of Washington, who came here to meet the remains of the late Governor Cosgrove, expressed the belief that through a compromise, which may be proposed by his state, the boundary question in which Oregon and Washington have been interested in for so many months may be settled economically to both parties.

Governor Hay says it is his plan, if feasible, to open negotiations with Governor Benson, of Oregon. In the hope that a committee from the two states be appointed to inspect that portion of the Columbia river in dispute. The case was once decided by the United States supreme court, but through a petition granting a rehearing the whole matter was reopened.

"I do not think any state should engage in litigation, if it is possible to avoid it," said the governor last night, at the Commercial Club. "It would be much better and cheaper for Washington and Oregon to reach an agreement out of court. I do not doubt that this can be accomplished if the proper steps are taken. A short time ago, after discussing the boundary dispute with Attorney-General Bell, I suggested that he take the question up with the attorney-general of Oregon. Since then I have been too busy to take the matter up again, but I intend to do so immediately."

Should a committee decide upon a boundary line, it is Governor Hay's idea to then submit the decision to the legislatures of Washington and Oregon for ratification.

CHICAGO GETS QUITE SPORTY

Chicago, March 31.—In an endeavor to put the kibosh on the fighting game in New York, San Francisco and Los Angeles, the sporting men of this city today are preparing plans for a reopening of flat attractions here. The mayor has been assured that the sport will be conducted along clean lines, and that there will be as little wrangling among promoters as possible.

It is intimated that Mayor Busse has assured the promoters that if these guarantees are carried out he will not interfere with the fighting game for a time at least.

Already several matches are under way, and it is thought that the first will open within three weeks. It is predicted that the first will go between "Cyclone" Thompson and Battling Nelson. Packy McFarland has also been communicated with, and, as he is always a card here, it is likely he also will be seen in action.

MURDER MYSTERY AT COOS BAY

Marshfield, Or., March 31.—A murder mystery in the death of Alex. Carlson, a mill hand, whose mutilated body has just been found floating in the Isthmus Inlet, near here, is today engaging the attention of the whole Coos Bay country, while the officers of the law are working hard to solve it.

That the man was murdered for his money and then thrown into the waters there is no doubt in the minds of the investigators. His head was crushed, and other evidences of a terrible crime were noticeable on the body.
