WINS BIG SUIT AGAINST RAILROAD

Spokane, Wash., April 1.—Joseph H. Boyd, president of the National Iron Works of this city, is today receiving the congratulations of his friends with a broad smile, for he has just won a victory over the Northern Pacific Railroad after being in litigation for 23 years. The judgment just handed down by Judge Whitson of the United States Circuit Court, holds that the railroad must pay Boyd \$100,000, the amount the iron man says he advanced to the contractor who built the road bed of the Coeur D'Alone Railway and Navigation Company. The suit began in 1886. Later the company failed. The property with the lawsuit, was taken over by the Northern Pacific Railroad.

OBJECTS TO MOVING ARMY HEADQUARTERS

Portland Or., April 1.—That President Taft is opposed to the proposition of moving the army headquarters from Vancouver, Wash., to Seattle, is the gist of a telegram just received from C. T. Whitney, vice president of the Portland Chamber of Commerce, who is now at the National capital. However, the message says nothing will be done regarding the change until after Senator Warren and his committee visit the Western forts during the coming summer. The proposition to take the army headquarters away from Vancouver, where they have been for so many years, has aroused a great deal of opposition on the part of the Portland business men, who sell the fort a great many supplies. By moving the headquarters to Seattle, as proposed, it is figured that order for supplies would be placed there.

SPOKANE IS TO HAVE A "HONK FEST"

Spokane, Wash., April 1.—Automobile enthusiasts are going to adopt the theory that there is more than one way to kill a cat in their efforts to have the horn-blowing ordinance repealed. Recently the city council passed a measure requiring every automobile owner to "honk, honk" when approaching every street corner. The autoists have decided to obey the ordinance, but in a more vigorous manner than the law requires. At a meeting called to discuss the situation they decided that the most effective way to make the people in general disgusted with the "toot" ordinance was for every man running a machine to "honk" long and loud. It is thought that if this plan is adopted pedestrians—and surely the policeman on the corner—will rise up and demand that the ordinance is nothing more than a nuisance and should be put to death.

TO CARRY FREIGHT AROUND THE HORN

San Francisco, April 1.—Promising to carry freight at a rate of seven and a half cents less than the Pacific Mail charges, Bates & Chesbrough have added four new steel sailing ships to their fleet, and these will be used to make regular trips to New York around the Horn from this port. Each vessel will make the trip in 120 days, and, on the basis of the capacities of the ships, it is estimated that 30,000 tons of freight can be handled by the new fleet. Shippers from this state believe that they can profitably take advantage of the increases and cheaper facilities for getting their freight into New York. In sending their produce by sea, they are saved warehouse and fire insurance charges. Canned salmon, canned fruits and vegetables, and dried fruits are some of the commodities now being sent by sailing vessel to the East.
