HORSE FAIR WILL BE GREAT EXHIBIT

The entries for the big horse show are nearly complete, and there is assurance of a first-class exhibit of horses, rigs and harness. The entries in the draft horse class are filling up in nice shape and on any fine working animals which will compete for prizes are entered from places miles away. The entire county will be represented with horses and there are several outside counties that will show their stock at the fair.

The driving class, both single and double, will be a pretty display this year, and owing to the first prize being awarded to an animal from the outside last fair, Salem buggy horse owners are determined to put a prize winner between the shafts of the

finest rig they can procure. There has been considerable flurry over the saddle horse entries. More saddlers than before will be exhibited during the fair and the class will be high standard.

The show is to be held on Court street between Commercial and Church streets, where it was held last year, and nothing has been overlooked by the committee on arrangements to make the affair a thorough success. Last year the horse show here drew thousands of people from all over the state, and this season, the fair officials predict a still greater crowd of enthusiastic spectators. Portland will send up a big delegation, and there will be visitors both from southern and eastern Oregon.

INDICT SOME OF THE MORAL SQUAD

Portland, Or., April 1.—"Moral squad" methods, the kind that made Portland's police department famous, have been given a severe jolt by the indictment of Police Sergeant Joseph Klenlen and two other policemen who are accused of misconduct in making a few recent night raids on hotels and even homes.

It is generally believed that the action of the grand jury will end the raids that have been condemned even by the better class of Portland's population. On several occasions, records show, the "moral squad" have invaded private premises without warrants and forced husbands to crawl out of bed in the middle of the night and search their trunks for the marriage license.

So many complaints were made and public sentiment condemned the practice with such vehemence that Chief Gritzmacher a few days ago, disbanded the squad. Further condemnation of the methods is found in the indictment, which was returned on the testimony of George I. Smith, whose apartments in the Quella Hotel the squad entered and flashed a dark lantern around the sleeping room. Smith presented his marriage license for examination and then the officers departed.

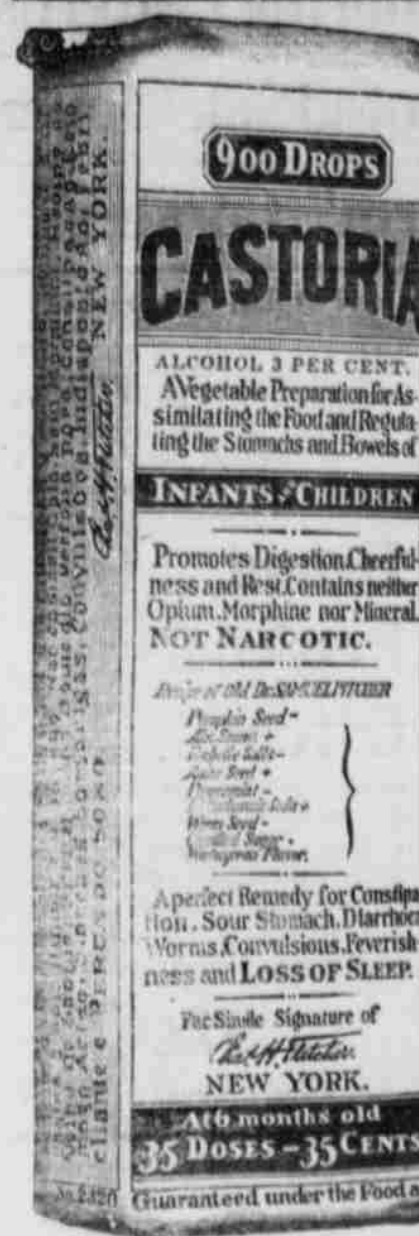

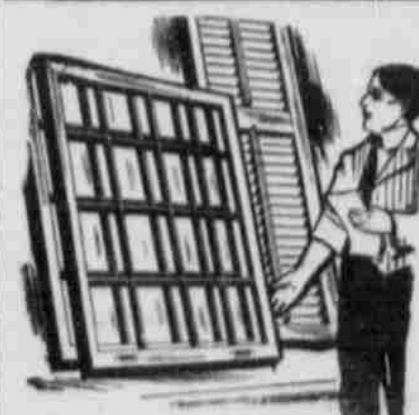
