Honolulu, April 6.—Although Andrew Carnegie promised to give Hawaii a library costing \$150,000, if the citizens would guarantee to maintain it in a suitable manner, the lawmakers of the islands are not yet unanimously in favor of the proposition and it is doubtful at present whether or not the ironmaster's offer will be accepted under the conditions which he has laid down.
