The Agricultural Law expresses the necessary quality of milk solids to relieve milk of the stigma of adulteration. In People vs. Bosch, 114 New York Supplement, 65, the New York Supreme Court decided that if the milk came within the provisions of the statute it was adulterated, and that it was sold in precisely the same form as it was drawn from the cow was no defense.
