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ALASKA HUNTERS FROZEN

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Seattle, April 19.—According to mail advices just received here from Valdez, Alaska, two hunters were killed and a third badly frozen as the result of an unusually high tide flooding their tent on the beach near Homer, Kachemak bay. The men were on a hunting trip and camped for the night on the beach above the high tide line. During the night a blizzard arose which carried the water over the spot on which they lay asleep. While groping about in the storm without clothing or means to make a fire, two of them, Miller and Valentine, were overcome by cold and died. The survivor, John Kares, managed to keep from freezing until the next day, when he was picked up by Indians and taken to Seldovia. He will probably lose both feet.

MOTOR CYCLE HAS THE SPEED RECORD

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Los Angeles, April 19.—Jake de Rosier is today the premier speed marvel of the world. On the Coliseum track yesterday he established the marvelous record of 80 miles in 97 minutes, 59 3-5 seconds, including the time consumed by three stops.

De Rosier was using a seven-horsepower motor cycle. Eddie Lingenfelder of Chicago, on a single cylinder four-horsepower machine, was four and a half laps behind the winner. The new record set by De Rosier surpasses any previously made by any owner propelled machine, including automobiles and locomotives.

LEADER FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD

Berkeley, Cal., April 19.—Fayette A. Lewis of Anaheim, Cal., has been chosen by the members of the University of California baseball team that downed Stanford in the memorable 17-inning struggle Friday, to lead the Blue and Gold players in 1910.

Lewis is a junior student at the state university, and played second base throughout the season which just ended. He has played on the team two years.

WOMAN FOUND GEMS IN ASHES

San Francisco, April 19.—Mrs. C. S. Littman of this city is rejoicing today over the recovery of gems valued at \$250 which she believed to have been stolen from her home. The family ash can was the repository of the missing jewels.

Saturday Mrs. Littman reported to the police that a solitary diamond ring and other rings set with turquoises and sapphires had been stolen from her home, and a systematic search of the pawn shops was instituted. Late last night she informed headquarters that a tip had resulted in the discovery of the gems lying in the ashes that had been carried out the day before.

STEAMER MAKES A NEW RECORD

San Francisco, April 19.—The steamer President today holds a new record for fast time between Seattle and San Francisco, having made the run in less than 49 hours, rivaling ordinary train speed.

The President, which was recently put into commission by the Pacific Coast Steamship Company, is running between Puget Sound ports, San Pedro and San Diego. She was due in this port at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon. Instead of loading along on schedule time, the ship "let herself out," and arrived before 10 a. m.
