OREGON IDAHO DEVELOPMENT CONGRESS

The Oregon-Idaho Development Congress to be held at Weiser on April 30, May 1 and May 2, promises to be the biggest affair of its kind ever held in southern Idaho. The Oregon Short Line railroad has authorized an open rate of two cents a mile in each direction from all O. S. L. stations to Weiser and return, tickets from stations east of Nampa good going April 29 and April 30, and tickets from stations Boise to Huntington, inclusive, good going April 29, April 30 and May 1, return limit of tickets May 3.

The program will be interspersed with music and other entertaining. The program will be held Friday and Saturday at the Wheaton theatre, one of the finest buildings of its kind in the west, and the Saturday evening session, which will be short, will be followed by a banquet at the I. O. O. F. hall, furnished by the ladies of the Outlook Club of Weiser.

Visitors from out of town will be taken in automobiles and buggies and shown the points of interest in and around the city, and on Sunday, May 2, the Pacific and Idaho Northern railway will run an excursion to Evergreen, which is tendered by Col. E. M. Heigho, vice president and general manager of the road, in conjunction with the Weiser Commercial club.

The handsome new quarters of the Weiser Commercial club have been entirely renovated and equipped with suitable furnishings and will be thrown open to visitors during the sessions of the congress. Colonel Heigho, chairman of the executive committee, having the matter in charge, is earnest in urging every community, great and small, in southern Idaho and southern Oregon which is interested in the development of this part of the country, to send strong delegations to this congress, and everything indicates that visitors will be given "the time of their lives."

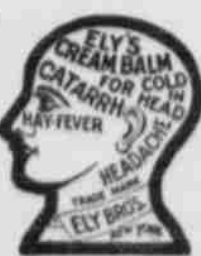

GERMAN SOCIETY ACTIVE

Site Selected for New Hall and Will Erect New Building for Their Use.

The German society, at its regular monthly meeting, took in about 20 new members and adjourned to meet in one week to close up a very important real estate transaction. The committee on May Festival decided to hold it in the Savage grove Saturday afternoon, May 23, with a musical and literary program. The committee on building site reported following pieces of property that had been offered them:

Lot 75½x165, corner Commercial and Ferry, \$8000.

Lot on Liberty street, between Court and State, 50x165, \$8000. This lot has two party walls.

Lot on Court between Liberty and High, 42x75, \$6500.

Lot on High between Court and Chemeketa, 42x75, with house, \$5000.

The committee recommended the first purchase, and about \$2000 was subscribed, in \$10 shares of stock, to bear 6 per cent interest, \$4000 cash down, and balance on five years' time. The committee have an option until May 3d, and the money will be raised by the committee this week. It is the intention to erect a hall for the society at an expense of about \$15,000.

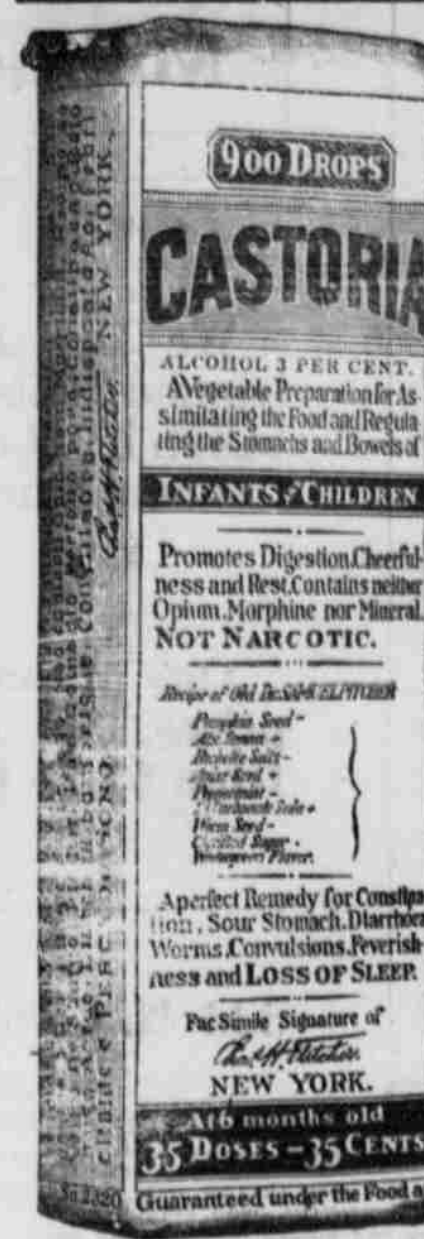
