AMERICAN TRUSTS ARE AFTER CHINA

San Francisco, May 11.—"John D. Rockefeller, Nut Vendor," is the shingle which may be hung in front of 26 Broadway, according to Bishop S. C. Spreng of Cleveland, O., who is here today on his way home from China.

Bishop Spreng says the Standard Oil Company has invaded the Orient with the same energy that has marked its operations in the United States. Rockefeller's agents have gone to the extent of attempting to control the output of a nut from which the Chinese make small quantities of oil, he says, although this industry has but slight future possibilities.

The tobacco trust has also reached into China, according to the bishop, and everywhere he visited, even far in the interior, he found the Orientals smoking American cigarettes.

SEATTLE TO ENTERTAIN JAP SQUADRON JUNE 3

Seattle, Wash., May 11.—Rear Admiral Ijichi, a command of the Japanese training squadron, and his staff, will be the guests of honor at the naval and military ball which will be given by the national guard of the state of Washington at the armory on the evening of June 3.

Besides the officers of the Japanese squadron and those of the national guard, there will be present 75 officers from the United States regular army, 15 from the revenue cutter service, 100 officers from the Pacific squadron and ten officers from the United States navy at Bremerton.

All of the army and navy officers will be in full dress, and the event is expected to be a brilliant affair.

An invitation has been forwarded to Vancouver, B. C., to the Duke of Connaught to bring his famous company of rifles to the ball.

WASHINGTON STATUE READY FOR SHIPMENT

Seattle, Wash., May 11.—The Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition officials have set aside \$5000 to pay the balance due Lorado Taft on the statue of George Washington, which is to be unveiled at the exposition June 14. The statue is almost colossal. The figure has been cast at Chicago, and is now ready for shipment to Seattle. It will be placed on a temporary pedestal in Puget Plaza at the exposition grounds, and when the fair is ended a permanent place will be selected by the board of regents of the University of Washington, which will be the custodian of the monument.

Judge C. H. Hanford, president of the American Revolution, will preside at the unveiling ceremony. The presentation will be made by Mrs. Elizabeth Perry Leary, on behalf of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

TO EXAMINE STATE TREASURER'S OFFICE

Seattle, Wash., May 11.—Chairman Allen, of the legislative investigating committee, stated today that the committee would comply with the request of State Treasurer J. G. Lewis that his office be investigated. Governor Hay yesterday forwarded to Chairman Allen the letter written by Treasurer Lewis, in which he expressed a desire that the affairs of his office should be inquired into. Lewis says that he has no reason to believe that any suspicion is entertained by the committee in regard to his office, but for the sake of setting the public at rest concerning the condition of the state funds in his department, he desires a full investigation.

"This report, coming voluntarily from the state treasurer opens the way to look into all state offices," said Chairman Allen today.

"I shall favor not only checking up the cash and securities in the hands of the state treasurer, but go down the line with the other offices, so far as the time at our disposal will permit."

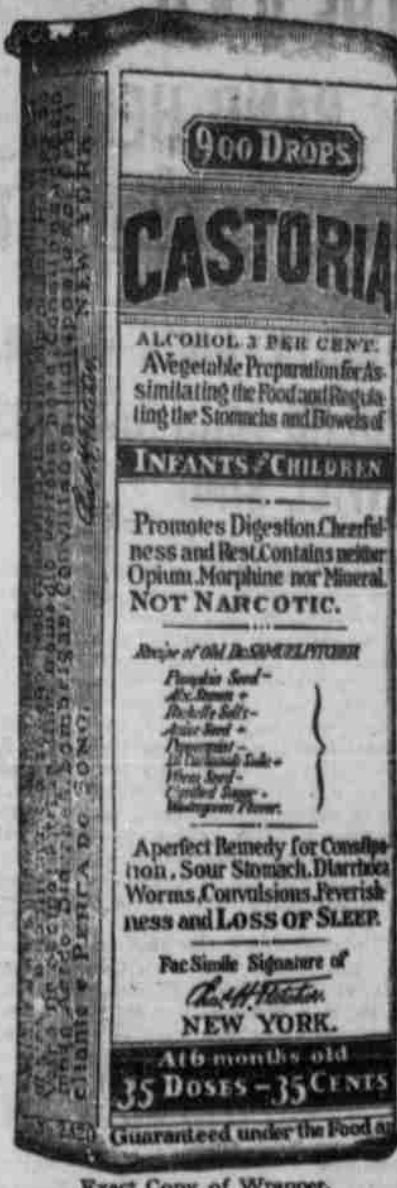
