ENGLAND WORRIED ABOUT HER FLEET

[United Press Leased Wire.] London, May 12.—Whether or not the Lord Nelson type of battleship actually is superior and more efficient than the later Dreadnaught type is a question that is agitating the whole of Britain today as a result of the reported division of opinion among the members of the secret naval commission that is now probing the condition and status of the British navy. It is true that the Lord Nelson type is a more powerful and formidable war machine, then England has wasted hundreds of millions of dollars in the construction of her immense Dreadnaught fleet.

This Commission was appointed, primarily to investigate the charges brought by Admiral Boscawen that the navy is unfit for war. While it is understood that this charge has not been substantiated, it is said that an additional charge, claiming the superiority of the Lord Nelson type of battleship, is still an object of investigation. The general uneasiness the charge has caused is augmented by the fact that Dreadnaughts now under construction represent an outlay of \$125,000,000.

CAME TO THE COAST SIXTY-TWO YEARS AGO

[United Press Leased Wire.] Mexico City, Mex., May 12.—Arrangements are being made today for the funeral of General John R. Frisbie, western pioneer and founder of Vallejo, Cal. General Frisbie died at his home here yesterday at the age of 86 years. He leaves a fortune estimated at more than half a million.

General Frisbie went to California with Stevenson's regiment in 1847. He married the daughter of General Vallejo, and lived in Sonoma county, Cal., for a number of years.

In 1878 he came to Mexico and at different times was engaged in the brokerage business, in mining and in the sugar industry.

He was born in New York, May 20, 1823.
