ROBBED A CARLOAD OF PLUG TOBACCO

[United Press Leased Wire.] Sacramento, Cal., May 13.—Seven men are under arrest here today as a result of an attempt last night to rob a car of tobacco in the Southern Pacific yards last night. The men, who are connected with a well-known cigar house in this city, are F. Rossi, Frank Ellis, Christ Nossel, Charles Dawson, Christin Apichino, Frank Moran and Henry Johnson. Special Officer W. S. Biggs, of the Southern Pacific Company, apprehended two men in the act of robbing the car last night. When they presented pistols the officer disarmed and arrested them. When they were left with the train men while the officer pursued the others, they escaped. Today they were arrested with five others, some of whom are suspected of recent holdups. Tobacco thefts in this city have cost the Southern Pacific Company several thousand dollars within the past half year.

BEAR WAS KILLED ON A CITY STREET

[United Press Leased Wire.] Bellingham, Wash., May 13.—The sports are today overhauling and oiling their artillery in preparation for possible further invasion of the city limits by adventuresome bears. The slaying of a big black bear on a downtown street yesterday has created excitement among the sporting men, and bear may soon take the place of porthouse steaks. After wandering about the beach yesterday afternoon, the bear, which had ventured from the woods, ambled up Chestnut street, in the business district, to the crowded public market. Hundreds of people watched bruln, who seemed inclined to make a feast off the vegetables displayed in the stalls, but his career was cut short by W. T. Hutton, a rancher, who shot the animal with a large calibre revolver.

PRISONER LOCKED DEPUTY IN JAIL

[United Press Leased Wire.] Vancouver, Wash., May 13.—Every possible exit from the city of Vancouver is being watched today for Charles Kitchen, who, after locking Deputy Sheriff G. Johnson behind the bars, escaped from the county jail, where he was awaiting removal to the pen to serve 15 years for burglary. When Johnson entered the cell room yesterday Kitchen seized his keys, slammed the heavy jail door in his face and escaped through the front door. Officer Cresap, attracted by the feeble fugitive, fired two bullets from his revolver, but Kitchen dodged them. Mrs. Sappington, wife of the sheriff, heard Johnson screams, and released him.

AUTOMOBILE RACE NEW YORK TO SEATTLE

[United Press Leased Wire.] Weiser, Idaho, May 13.—The Thomas car, acting as pathfinder for the ocean-to-ocean automobile race from New York to Seattle, to be run this summer, has passed through this city, and today is on its way to Baker City, Ore. The machine, which is the same one that made the recent trip around the world, is in fairly good condition, in spite of the many breakdowns that have occurred, owing to bad roads. The party in the car is composed of George Miller, driver; L. W. Reddington, manager; C. W. Eaton, mechanic, and J. M. Ely, photographer.
