THE SPOTTED CAYUSE RETURNED TO THE KING

[United Press Leased Wire.] London, May 15.—In the language of the Turk, King Edward today is being given the "horse laugh" by his cronies because the deposed sultan of Turkey, now plain Mr. Abdul Hamid, saw fit to return to the King a curiously spotted horse that Edward had forwarded to Constantinople just before Abdul was dethroned.

The horse belonged to Richard Croker, who passed it over to the British monarch. Thinking that Abdul would be appreciative the king forwarded the animal to Turkey. The spotted horse remained at the Bynantine capital just a week eating high priced fodder at the expense of the British ambassador.

When it became apparent that the sultan would not need any freak horses, the steed was returned to England.

ENGLAND TO ADOPT NEW MILITARY SYSTEM

[United Press Leased Wire.] London, May 15.—With certain exceptions, every English youth between the ages of 15 and 21 will be compelled to serve a term of four continuous months in the territorial army, if a measure now being prepared by the National Service League meets with the approval of parliament.

The object of the measure is to raise the standard of military efficiency in the reserves available in case of war. After the four months of service scheduled for infantry, to which two additional months may be added for other departments of service, two weeks training in camp annually for three years will be compulsory.

REVIVAL MEETING IS WELL ATTENDED

The great union revival meeting, in the mammoth tabernacle tent on Fifteenth and street street, has been going on with increasing interest for a week. Rev. Guy Phelps, the state holiness evangelist, and Rev. David McInturf, the Scotch mountain evangelist, as he is called, have met here in Salem for an earnest campaign of religious work.

Near 50 converts and those accepting the teaching of sanctification have been reported. Many of the pastors in the city are united in this work, and lending all the assistance possible. The day meetings are held by some of the resident pastors occasionally, but the two evangelists alone preach in the evening, they alternating.
