GREAT BASEBALL GAME SCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY

There will be an awful dust raised out at the Asylum avenue ball park next Sunday afternoon, when the J. G. Mack Company set their nine diamond artists on the field against the Salem Independent team, and the contest starts for the \$200 purse, which was put up by a popular local sport.

In order that the Salem fans will not be superstitious regarding Managers Heyser and Jernan's team which will play against the J. G. Mack aggregation, the following line up has been prepared by them for publication, with the understanding that these men are to appear on the field ready for action next Sunday afternoon: Fred Heyser, catcher; Chester Bowen, pitcher; Fred Carey, first base; Roberts, second base; Bert Johnson, shortstop; John Humphreys, third base, and the outfield will be composed of Jernan, Ott, Rhodes and Jones, subject to change.

Chester Bowen is a well-known twirler to all the Salem fans, and he has been pitching excellent ball so far this season at Dallas and other places. With Bowen in the box and Bert Johnson at shortstop, the Salem Independent team will be strengthened somewhat near 100 per cent. It is a very easy matter to figure out why these additional members to the team will prove valuable. Bert Johnson plays the position at short, that being his original place in the diamond, and Johnson's ability is not questioned by any one who has ever had an occasion to see him in action. His ground covering, his base-throwing and his batting is high above the average, and his knowledge of the game is a great benefit to any team of which he is a member. On the other hand, Bowen is what is known as a successful amateur pitcher. He has been subjected to several defeats, which is a part of baseball every pitcher must overcome, but of late Bowen has been holding his own in extra fast company. He has struck out 12 men this season in one game, and has several games to his credit with four and less hits, and his arm is improving in strength, and his control is good. With Heyser behind the plate, great things can be expected from Bowen, as the big German backstop can always be relied upon to keep his traces from dragging, and the encouragement he gives a pitcher is also an important factor in the game. Taking Salem's new infield into consideration, Carey on first, Roberts second and Humphreys third, a ball must be pounded an awful lick to go through the men at the stations for a hit.

A lineup of the J. G. Mack team has also been handed in for the approval of the Salem fans, as follows: Summerville first base, Larry second base, Fay shortstop, Harvey Newell third base, Shea catcher and Gardner pitcher. In the outfield there will be F. Gardner, Reed and Hulsman.

The only new players the J. G. Mack Company have engaged are Newell and Shea. Newell is a well-known ball player all along the coast and a former member of the Tri-City League in this city. He has been in California for the past year, and, while playing in that locality he has fattened up his batting average wonderfully.

The prospects for a first-class, interesting game of ball is most promising for next Sunday, and a large crowd is expected to be on hand to see the two independent aggregations dig into each other.

GOLDEN GATE PARK THREATENED WITH WATER

[United Press Leased Wire.]

San Francisco, May 17.—Subterranean springs today threaten to inundate several acres of Golden Gate Park, and a crew of laborers is at work throwing up dykes around Mallard Lake, which is rising rapidly. Unless the water begins to recede within the next few days a pumping plant or drainage system will have to be installed.

The lake began to rise several days ago. At first it was believed that the water drained from surrounding hills was responsible, and there is still some home that this is the cause. Experts, who have been investigating the sudden rise of the lake, however, are confident that the new springs have formed at the bottom of the pond, and that the water will not be checked until a system of carrying it away is installed.

Under normal conditions the lake is but five feet deep. Today it is 15 feet deep, and still rising. South Drive is under water for several hundred feet.
