PULLMAN CHAMPION COLLEGE DEBATERS

Spokane, Wash., May 18.—The Washington State College today claims the title of champion debaters of the Northwest, and the claim is not disputed, for the team from that institution last night easily defeated their opponents from the Oregon Agricultural college in a championship contest.

"Resolved, That all cities of the Northwest with a population of 50,000 or more should adopt the commission form of government, patterned after the Des Moines system," was the question. The affirmative was supported by the Washington State College, represented by L. F. Harrison, J. T. Longfellow and Dana T. Murdock. The team from Oregon was composed of J. W. Darling, S. A. Wilson and R. E. Kere. The judges decided two to one in favor of the Pullman school.

ASSAULTED TEACHER AND GOT THE LIMIT

INLAND EMPIRE IS WELL SOAKED

Spokane, Wash., May 18.—With the fertile wheat fields of the Inland Empire soaked six inches from the surface by the precipitation during the last two days, ground at greater depth dampened by snows, the weather turning warmer and growing grain well started, jubilant ranchmen throughout the district predict the greatest wheat yield in years. Telegraphic reports gathered today from 60 towns in Eastern and Central Washington, Northern Idaho and Oregon tell of a heavy warm rain in the past three days, giving fields sufficient moisture to last until fall seasons bring cooler weather.

Crops of fruits have been aided, and with warm weather, prunes, cherries, apples, pears and apricots will be harvested in abundance.

UNWRITTEN LAW SENDS MAN TO JAIL

New York, May 18.—Captain Peter C. Hains, sentenced to from 8 to 16 years' imprisonment for slaying William E. Annis, was taken to prison today. He decided not to appeal for a writ of reasonable doubt, going to prison and beginning his sentence while his case is being carried to the appellate division of the supreme court. In the event that he loses his appeal he will have a portion of his time already served, by adopting this plan, while, if he refused to go to prison, he would be confined in the Tombs and still face his full term.

Hains was accompanied to prison by his father and brother.

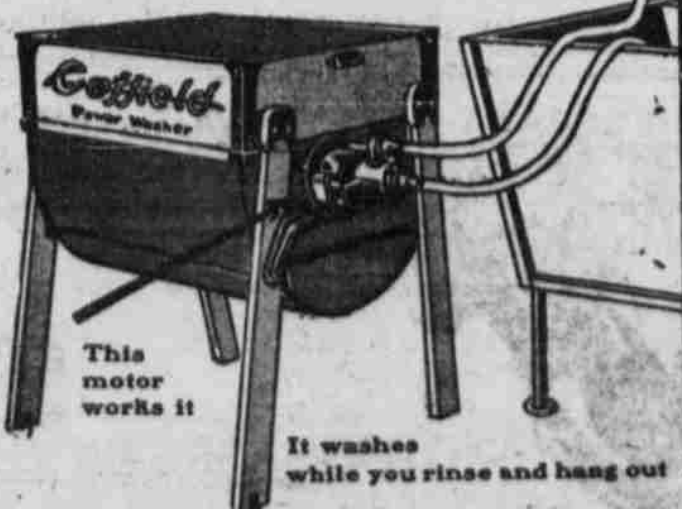
