CAUSED

BECAUSE HE DID'NT LIKE THE STREET CAR

While one of the big Oregon Elecwhite one of the big Oregon Elec-tric cars was passing down Broadway last evening, in North Salem, a young shepherd dog belonging to P. W. Reyelts, the proprietor of the busy little butcher shop on South Commercial street, ran out on the track in front of the moving car, which struck him on the head so hard the unfortunate pup could not sur-Mr. Reyelts was driving along the side of the track at the time, and when the dog was thrown aside by the car, the mare which he was driving became frightened and plunged to one side of the road, colliding with a laundry wagon near the curb and tipped it over. The driver of the laundry wagon, John Bellamy was thrown out with such force it fractured the bones in his foot. In the meantime Reyelts' frightened horse ran down Broadfrightened horse ran down Broad-way, and the driver was unable to stop her until she had ran three blocks, on account of the hold-back traps giving away. He finally suc-ceeded in quieting the animal with-out further damage. Dr. E. E. Fisher was summoned at once to attend Bellamy's inurjies.

No one could be held responsible for the accident, as the canine was the cause of Reyelts' mare becoming frightened, the cause of the laundry wagon upsetting, that the cause of Bellamy's injury, and the dog, the careless cause of the whole trouble, is beyond all blame, being dead.
