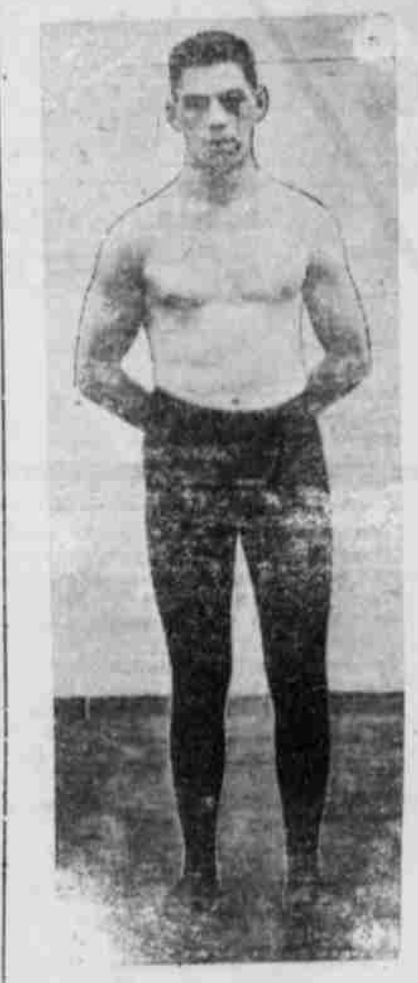

SEATTLE MAY HAVE ANOTHER THROUGH LINE
 [United Press Leased Wire.]
 Vancouver, B. C., May 21.—Before taking his departure for the East over the Canadian Pacific railroad today, A. W. Treholm, general manager of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis & Omaha railroad at St. Paul, who, in company with a party of Chicago & Northwestern railway officials, has been making a tour of the Pacific Northwest, declared that, while he did not speak officially, he believed it to be the purpose of the great Vanderbilt system to extend its line to Seattle and other Puget Sound cities.
 It is understood to be the intention of the Northwestern to reach the coast by an extension of the Black Hills line, whose western terminus is Lander, Wyo. It is reported that surveyors are now engaged in location work in Idaho, and that the Northwestern system is the real backer of the mysterious North Coast line now building westward from Spokane.
