TWO MEN WITH GUNS BEAT GAMBLING GAME

[United Press Leased Wire.] Bingham, Utah, May 21.—Three posers are scouring the country today in search of two bandits who held up the Combination saloon and gambling house at 2 o'clock this morning.

The holdup was executed in true frontier style. Two masked men entered the gambling house simultaneously from different doors, covering with their guns 15 men who were playing roulette and faro.

Ordering the gamblers to line up facing the wall, one of the robbers guarded them while the other looted the banks of the games, securing \$500. The robbers then backed out of a rear door and made their escape. An alarm was given, posers hastily organized and the pursuit begun. The robbers got but little start of their victims but managed to elude them in the darkness. The pursuers are heavily armed and if they overtake the bandits a battle and lynching will probably ensue.
