NEW YORKERS INDICTED FOR LAND FRAUDS

[United Press Leased Wire.] Cheyenne, Wyo., May 24.—Eight men prominent in financial circles of New York City are today under indictments voted by the federal grand jury which investigated cases in which it was charged that the defendants defrauded the government out of thousands of acres of valuable coal land in Big Horn county, Wyoming.

Three years ago the land was filed upon and the entries have been under investigation for 18 months. The men indicted are Frank T. Wells, S. W. Gebo, George W. Dally, Wilberforce Scully, John Nelson, Thomas McDonald, Rufus J. Ireland and John B. Wright. Against Gebo, Dally, Nelson, Scully and Wright two indictments each were returned. The same jury also indicted ten prominent Laramie county ranchmen for illegal fencing of public lands.

SHE WAS HYPNOTIZED WHEN SHE MARRIED

[United Press Leased Wire.] Santa Rosa Cal., May 24.—That she was hypnotized and coerced into marriage when she was 14 years of age, and that her three children were stolen from her a year and a half ago, are the allegations made in the divorce complaint filed by Mrs. Margaret McWilliams, the hearing of which will occupy the attention of the local court during the coming month. The woman's husband, J. D. McWilliams, is said to be a professional hypnotist. She was married to him seven years ago. During these years, according to her complaint, in addition to beatings and other forms of cruelty, an attempt was made to incarcerate her in an asylum. According to advices received here when Mrs. McWilliams accompanied an officer to her husband's ranch near San Diego to see papers in the suit, McWilliams drove the officer away with a gun and escaped toward the Mexican boundary with the children.

THE NOBLE LORD SAYS "HE NEVER SAID IT"

[United Press Leased Wire.] London, May 24.—That Lord Ronaldshay's apology for publicly calling the Countess of Granard, who was Miss Beatrice Mills, of New York, "a dumpy American hussy for fortune enough to secure a title," was made at the expressed desire of her king, is generally believed here today. The countess recently opened a bazaar organized by Ronaldshay's opponent, Ronaldshay is a unionist member of the house of commons from the Hornsey division of Middlesex. He was much irritated, and his remark was thought to be the result of political jealousy.

TAKES HEADACHE OUT OF INTOXICANTS

[United Press Leased Wire.] Berkeley, Cal., May 25.—If a recent discovery by Professor E. J. Voyle, a chemist of this city, possesses the virtue claimed for it, corn juice devotees and celebrators of Saturday night may soon enjoy their revels without reservation or disturbing thought of a dark brown morning after. Voyle claims the "headache" of booze is contained in the cyanide of its composition, and not in the alcohol. By extracting the cyanide the exhilarating effects of the evening's libations may be retained with no fear of later "complications." The chemist predicts his discovery will work a revolution in distilling processes.

OPENS MILLION ACRES TO SETTLEMENT

[United Press Leased Wire.] Washington May 24.—President Taft Saturday signed a proclamation opening to settlement and entry a million acres of farm lands in the Coeur d'Alene Indian reservation in Idaho, the Spokane reservation in Washington, and the Flathead reservation in Montana. Coeur d'Alene is made the point of drawing for all three.

THREE DROWNED NEAR EVERETT

[United Press Leased Wire.] Everett, Wash., May 24.—The bodies of John H. Collins, manager of the new Western Shingle Company, of Lowell, and two laborers, whose names are unobtainable, are today lying at Colville, the men having been drowned near Camano Island Friday night. Collins and the two laborers set out in a yawl to meet the steamer Camano. The first intimation of the tragedy became known yesterday afternoon when the three bodies were found lying on the beach, where they had been cast by the sea. It is supposed that the yawl was run down and sunk by the steamer.
