THE FIRST FINDERS OF GOLD NUGGETS FOUND WITH SKELETONS OF PREHISTORIC RACE

[United Press Leased Wire.] Sacramento, May 24.—"Found with the bones of Indians, who are supposed to have lived during the stone age."

This is the entry made today in the books in the office of the state controller to account for the presence in the treasury of gold and trinkets worth \$145, unearthed in an Indian burial ground near Monterey.

The state law provides that property unclaimed by heirs shall revert to the state. Deeming it unlikely that heirs to stone age residents of Monterey county will make application for the legacy, the treasury has become the repository for the valuable legacy.

SOUTHERN PACIFIC CO. PLANS IMPROVEMENTS

Superintendent Fields and Engineer Bollins, of the S. P. Co., had a conference at Salem Wednesday with the local committee consisting of Mayor Rodgers, President McNary, of the Board of Trade, and F. G. Deekabach, in regard to proposed improvements in the freight and passenger depots and grounds. The plans of the Harriman people were submitted to the above local committee, who are in charge of the matter, and great changes are impending that are not yet fully agreed upon. In a general way it is learned that the capacity of the freight depot will be doubled, and the grounds at the passenger station will be improved.
