CHINESE SWINDLER KILLED AT HONG KONG

[United Press Leased Wire.]

the murder of Lew Sue Kay, imperial scheme inspector of industries, at Hong Kong last Monday, received by local Minister Wu Ting Fang, and led to Washington.

The murdered official and two companions were arrested in Pittsburg last April, accused of mining swindles, which were said to have netted them \$1,500,000. Minister Wu intervened on behalf of the imprisoned Chinese, and they were released a few days later. Lew re-turned to China, and Monday was found dead in his apartments in a Hong Kong hotel, his body pierced with eight knife wounds.

Chinese here believe that one of Lew's victims followed him to China, and committed the murder. A re-ward of \$50,000 has been offered for the arrest of the assausin,






