J. V. ROBINSON OF SALEM INVENTS AN AUTOMATIC AIR HOSE COUPLING

Joseph V. Robinson, a Salem lad 19 years of age, has invented an automatic air brake attachment which will be the means of saving thousands of lives yearly, notwithstanding the many dollars which the railroad companies expend annually for repairs and installing of connecting air hose.

This new invention entirely does away with hand connection of air hose between freight and passenger cars, which is probably the most dangerous part of the trainman's work. Among the many innovations that have been introduced in recent years for the safety of the railroad employees, and the expediting of coupling and making up the trains in yards and terminals, the Robinson automatic connector is one of the most important improvements added to railway equipment and the following description will enable one to understand the exact working of the connector.

The signal, brake and steam pipe gaskets or packing rings are similar to those now used in the ordinary hose couplings, but not of the same dimensions, and are applied in a similar manner. On the face of the coupler are two contact points known as the male and female. One on one side of the drawhead and one on the other, and the gaskets project slightly in advance of the face of the coupler head. There are two powerful springs attached to each section of the coupler which, as soon as the sections meet and the drawheads are locked, will hold the connecting air hose tight and snug and yet allow a slight play for curvature and inequalities in the heights of cars and track owing to the connector operating on a ball and socket, and can be moved in all directions. Each connector head is provided with two guides which line up the connectors when the cars are being coupled which will bring all pipe connections directly together and with the assistance of the powerful steel springs, an unbreakable connection is made. There is no lock fastening to be contended with in the new invention which system costs the railroad people thousands of dollars annually for the breaking of air hose and worn out hose locks as the result of car pulling apart frequently or the brakeman's neglect on uncoupling cars to unfasten the air hose. The entire apparatus is suspended by a lug fastened to the car coupler head. The connectors will always be carried with the cars and will not be affected with weak draft gear springs. Therefore there is a constant distance between the two suspension points of the connector, always assuring the same tensions on the springs. Steam heat will also be more practicable and much money can be saved by the railroad people in eliminating the loss of steam due to unsecure connections made between passenger cars.

Much credit is due young Robinson for his clever invention over which he labored many months. The Westinghouse Air Brake company has encouraged Robinson and is anxious to secure the new invention, and the young inventor is now backed by the Safety Investment Company of Portland, who now have the patent gas shutoff contraption on the market, and he is receiving letters daily from the foremost mechanics in the United States asking for descriptions of his inventions. This is not the first invention young Robinson has made and within a few days another time-saving and valuable article will be completed for the inspection of the public. The air brake connector will be on exhibition at the Seattle fair and Robinson intends to get it before the railroad people in the shortest time possible.

IMPROVEMENTS SLATED FOR NEW ADDITION TO FAIRMOUNT PARK

The Meeker addition that has been put on the market by the Meyer & Belle Land Co., has been named Fairmount Park addition, and a number of improvements have been arranged for. A street 60 feet wide will be graded through the center of it from Commercial street to the top of Fairmount hill. A walk will be laid up there and about 500 feet in concrete will be laid on grade on Commercial street in front of the addition.

COTTAGE STREET TO BE PAVED SOUTH

A petition has been worked up by ex-Alderman Gesner for bitulithic pavement of South Cottage street from State to Trade. It will be presented on Monday night, and enough have signed the petition to insure its being ordered done. The property owners on North Cottage street are said to be also considering paving that street.

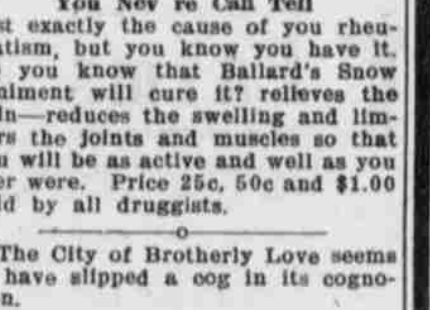
