The ordinance to put the treasurer on a flat salary and make him license collector with his office in the city hall will be up for passage.

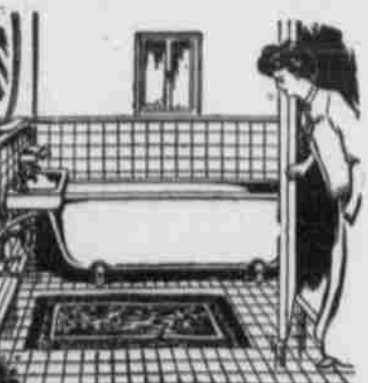
