SPENDS HER TIME IN DIVORCE COURTS

San Francisco, June 11.—Reports that Millionaire James C. Dunphy and his wife, whose marriage was recently annulled by the local courts, have become reconciled and will be remarried as soon as she can divorce herself from Julius Silverstone, a Portland attorney are current here today.

The rumors are based on the fact that Mrs. Dunphy or Silverstone has abandoned her appeal from the decision of a local court, which held that she is Silverstone's wife, her divorce from him being illegal.

Neither Dunphy or the woman will discuss the reports, but the fact that they have been seen together recently, and her attorneys' action in withdrawing the appeal is regarded by friends of the pair as conclusive evidence that their differences have been settled.

According to the reports, the woman will start suit for divorce from Silverstone at once.

Mrs. Silverstone-Dunphy's matrimonial experiences have been varied, and she has been in the divorce court much of the time since she was 16 years of age, a short time after she married the first of her four husbands.

None of her divorces attracted so

much attention as the Dunphy case. She sued the millionaire for divorce and was given the decree with \$60,000 alimony. Dunphy appealed and convinced the court that the marriage should be annulled and the judgment for alimony set aside. The woman filed an appeal from this finding, but late yesterday had the appeal withdrawn.

BARONESS URIU SAYS WOMAN'S SPHERE IS HOME

New York, June 11.—That America today may be ready for the ballot for women is a question upon which vice-admiral, declines to express an opinion, but that the women of Japan are not ready is her emphatic declaration.

"I will not put myself down as saying that I do not believe in suffrage for American women, as their problems and those of the women of Japan are wide apart," said the baroness. "I do not believe in the ballot personally, but I believe in the highest mental development for women. Co-education does not appeal to me, but colleges, such as Vassar, Smith,

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Wellsley and Bryan Mawr are a credit to your nation."

She continued: "I think women's and men's spheres are entirely different. A woman's brain is complimentary to that of her husband. Her usefulness in the world is of a different, but as important variety as that of man, but her place is the home."

"A woman may know politics, statesmanship, diplomacy and business, if she chooses, and not to her detriment, but to a higher usefulness in the home, and not outside of it."

LEACH CROSS READY TO FIGHT HYLAND
