Cook for hired men and help do all kinds of farm work as farms are almost shut down here. Of course I am getting thickly settled here, ten men for one job. It rains most of the time, times are so hard in the winter nothing much only washing and ironing, tired of that occupation.

We have three children one girl and two boys. Would be glad for some one to apply for us immediately we haven't means to get away from this place as everything is so high and all this is a school town, makes rent so high now if you have any friends as knows of any one who would be glad of a good family and oblige us very much. Haven't an extra stamp as I am in a hurry to get started. Sorry about the stamp but please mention this and get reward some time. He is 45 and I am 38, tolerably stout, and he is a good farm hand. There is plenty of places for us if people knowed us and we wait for an answer."

CAR BUILDERS ORDER BIG BILL OF LUMBER

[United Press Leased Wire.]

Seattle, Wash., June 11.—Washington lumbermen are highly pleased today by news from the East which is taken to indicate the revival of buying in the lumber industry. The news reached the city in the form of specifications for lumber orders aggregating more than 12,000,000 feet, which is expected to bring into the Northwest a quarter of a million dollars.

The specifications come from car manufacturers in Chicago, St. Louis and Milwaukee, and call for car material, including car siding, sills, framing and lining, and the best quality is wanted.

The Milwaukee and Chicago specifications state that the materials are for use in the manufacture of 1500 refrigerator cars for the Northern Pacific railroad.

Another inquiry is from the American Car and Foundry Company of St. Louis, for a bill of lumber aggregating 2,000,000 feet of the best material.

These are the first large lumber orders that have been received in Washington for nearly a year, and lumbermen believe that the business now in sight heralds the return of old-time activity in the industry.

FELL INTO VAT OF BOILING WATER

Oakland, Cal., June 11.—His skin seared and his flesh literally cooked, Antonio Flori, 25 years of age, lies at the Emergency Hospital today, where little hope is held out for his recovery.

BRYAN IS CANDIDATE FOR U. S. SENATE

Omaha, Neb., June 10.—William Jennings Bryan, through Richard L. Metcalf, editor of the Commoner, today announced himself as candidate for the United States senate to succeed Senator Burkett, whose term expires in March, 1911.

Bryan will run for office under the direct primary law, which is modeled after the Oregon act. Members of the Nebraska legislature are elected in November, 1910. The primary will be held in September, 1910.
