CHINESE FLOUR KING TO VISIT PORTLAND

[United Press Leased Wire.] San Francisco, June 15.—Bound for Portland, Ore., to make the acquaintance of flour manufacturers for whom he is sole agent in the far east, and planning a visit to the Seattle Exposition, Juan Kal, the "four king" of China, is in San Francisco today. Quian is visiting old-time friends in this city, where he laid the foundation of his immense fortune years ago when he operated a shoe factory.

The Chinese merchant is one of the largest importers in the far east, his importations of flour alone amounting to millions of dollars. So large are his operations that Portland mills have handed over to him the exclusive right to handle their output in China, the Straits Settlements and Philippine Islands.

Quian came to San Francisco when a young man and immediately set about learning American business methods. Beginning as a shoe manufacturer, he soon owned a factory which employed 350 Chinese and 70 white men. Taking up other lines Quian branched out as dealer in silks and other Oriental goods in Mexico and Central America. Seventeen years ago he returned to China and took up the business of importing flour.

GEORGIA POSSESSES KING OF TIGHT-WADS

[United Press Leased Wire.] Atlanta, Ga., June 15.—Parsimony that will startle the most ardent disciple of rigid economy is charged against A. Lee Douglass, worth half a million of dollars, in a suit for divorce brought by Mrs. Emma Neal Douglass. Mrs. Douglass is worth, in her own right, \$300,000, and in view of the combined resources of the couple believed they should live in comfort.

In the complaint Mrs. Douglass alleges that during her honeymoon trip, her husband compelled her to pay for every meal she ate. He presented bills at the end of each month. She further alleged he would permit but one light to be used in the house at night, and objected if the servants were given anything more than bread to eat. The case has aroused unusual interest here.

TWO ORDINANCES PASSED TO REFORM CITY TREASURY

Alderman Greenbaum made progress in his fight to put the office of city treasurer on a more business-like basis. He has prepared three ordinances with the aid of the city attorney, which are to make the office self-sustaining, removing it to the city hall, where the records and city cash will have vault room. His three bills also make the treasurer license collector, putting him under a surety bond paid for by the city and will place him in a position to use all three city banks on equal terms. The third ordinance will increase the treasurer's salary from \$30 to \$50 per month. It was shown that with all the street improvement, sewers, water bonds, etc., the treasurer will handle nearly as much money this year as the county treasurer. Under the Greenbaum ordinance, if enforced, the city treasurer's office will become more than self-sustaining.

WHITE FIGHT FANS OBJECT TO NEGROES

[United Press Leased Wire.] Pittsburgh, Pa., June 15.—Jack Johnson, the colored champion, has been requested by wire to remain away from the ring-side tonight when James J. Jeffries will be the attraction in a six-round contest in Duquesne Garden. The management realized that if Johnson attends the show there will be a rush of negroes for the place. The white fans have drawn the color line, declaring they will not patronize the exhibition if negroes attend. It was reported that Johnson intended to come here and ask Jeff a number of questions at the ring-side.
