### STANFORD TO HAVE A TROLLEY LINE

[United Press Leased Wire.] Stanford University, Cal., June 16.—Preliminary surveys are being made today for the trolley line that to connect the university campus with the town of Palo Alto. The appearance of the engineers on the campus was hailed by the members of the university community as the first actual step toward bringing the hitherto isolated campus into direct touch with the outside world. Since the establishment of the university, visitors and students have been compelled to depend upon carriages and antiquated busses for transportation to and fro from the "quad." This state of affairs existed in deference to the expressed wishes of the founders. The first step in advance was taken a year ago, when the trustees of the university passed an order permitting automobiles to use one road on the extreme edge of the campus.

### VENEZUELA WILL OWN LINE OF STEAMERS

[United Press Leased Wire.] Washington, June 16.—The state department was officially notified through the American legation at Caracas, that the steamer Nanticoke and the tug Dispatch, suspected of being about to engage in a filibustering expedition to Venezuela, have been purchased by the Venezuelan government, and will be placed in the government navigation service on the Lake Maracaibo. It is understood that the new Venezuelan administration will place the vessels in competition with a private company, which was granted a monopoly by former President Castro. This private company is practically under Castro's control, despite the fact that he is barred from the republic of which he was once dictator.

### DEAF MUTE ARRESTED BECAUSE HE TALKED

[United Press Leased Wire.] Tacoma, Wash., June 15.—After a silence of 53 years, C. E. Vance a deaf mute, recovered his voice, only to be arrested for using it. Vance met two pretty girls on C street last night, and was so pleased that he spoke to them. The girls declared the mute had been for several days following and trying to "mash" them, and in police court today Vance was fined \$100. Vance's brother and neighbors were in court that the prisoner was born deaf, and that he has never spoken an intelligible word in his life. The girls, however, alleged he approached them in a very gay and lightsome mood and passed the compliments of the day. The judge accepted this version. This session of court was further enlivened when A. E. Bowman, a stranger from Oklahoma, was mulcted \$100 because he accosted a married woman whom he did not know. He pleaded loneliness, but Judge Arnton was obdurate, and Bowman paid the fine.

### TERRIFIC BOILER EXPLOSION AT DENVER

[United Press Leased Wire.] Denver, Col., June 16.—Three are known to be dead, one probably fatally injured, nine seriously injured and three missing as the result of the explosion of a 200-ton boiler in the power house of the Denver Gas and Electric Company, located at Sixth and Lawrence streets, at 6:30 last night. So terrific was the force of the explosion that the heavy boiler was thrown 800 feet into the air. It crashed through the roof of the plant, completely wrecking the generator and walls, cut off the lights, and for more than two hours the city was in darkness. Houses in the vicinity of the plant were rocked on their foundations. One of the first bodies taken out was that of Joseph Perri, age 7, who was playing in the alley behind the plant at the time of the explosion, and was crushed under the debris. The property damage is estimated at between \$250,000 and \$500,000.
