ASTORIA IS AFTER TERMINAL RATES

[United Press Leased Wire.] Portland, Or., June 17.—The chamber of commerce at Astoria, Ore., it was announced today, has filed a complaint with the Interstate Commerce Commission, asking that the Astoria & Columbia river railroad be compelled to give Astoria terminal rate on grain and farm products from the interior points of Oregon and Washington. The railroad in question is part of the Hill system. The commercial organization of the seaside city declares in its bill of complaint that it is entitled to the same terminal rates as those enjoyed by Portland and Puget Sound points. The question was brought up at the convention of the Farmers' Educational Co-Operative Union, at Pullman, Wash., and that body, after listening to the complaint, declined to have anything to do with the filing of it. Hence, the Astoria chamber of commerce decided to act independently.

K. OF P. PICNIC AT FALLS CITY SATURDAY

The Knights of Pythias of Falls City will have the picnic of the season Saturday, June 19. The hilarity will begin with a big parade at 10 o'clock, and there will be something going every minute from that time until "taps."

The parade will be headed by the uniform rank of the order, with the Chemawa band, merchants' floats, horse parade, plug uglies, citizens in carriages and on foot. There will be speech making, special drills by the uniform rank, a talk on Pythianism by W. L. Toose, ball games between Chemawa and Dallas and Falls City and Monmouth teams. Athletic sports of all kinds, wrestling, match horse racing, foot racing, and there will be prizes hung up for the events, all cash.

Hubbard will send a company of the uniform rank, 26 in number, who will go over in auto's passing through Salem about 6 o'clock Saturday morning. There will be a large number from Salem who will take advantage of the occasion to get acquainted with our neighbor, who is soon to be joined to us in the lasting bonds of steel rails.

LAW OVER CHECKS THAT ARE NOT YET DUE

[United Press Leased Wire.] Oakland, Cal., June 17.—Five checks, payable 17,000 years from date and representing a total sum of \$7950, have plunged the superior court into a maze of difficulties. The checks were drawn by A. S. Gotthelf, and are payable to Mrs. Sarah Bowman, since deceased.

Three of the checks were made payable in 19,010, the others in 19,012, and were found sealed in an envelope bearing the admonition in Mrs. Bowman's writing: "This is the property of A. S. Gotthelf, no one is to open it but himself." Gotthelf claimed that the words on the envelope amounted to a cancellation. He filed suits asking that such action be taken, and secured an order restraining A. J. Bowman, the executor of Mrs. Bowman's estate, from transferring the checks.

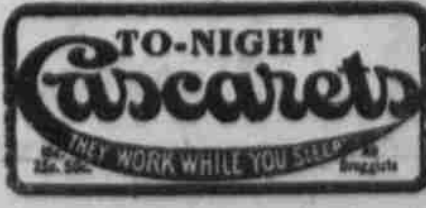
