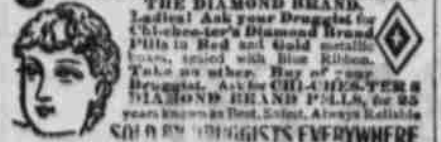

CHIEF OF POLICE SAYS LET 'EM KISS

"Let 'em kiss their heads off. Give them room," was the gist of an order handed down to the police of Pittsburg by Superintendent Thomas A. McQuaid, when asked for a decision on "spooning" in the big public parks of Pittsburg. As a result McQuaid is the most popular police official that has ever been in Pittsburg. What is still better, the great American privilege of a young man to take his best girl into the park and there kiss her, if she is willing, will no longer be curtailed in Pittsburg, in spite of the protests of the elderly ladies who have gone to see the chief of police to have love-making stopped in the parks. The police have been ordered not to interfere.

"I don't like the lovers' lanes in the parks—those long, dark ways where lovers have been in the habit of hiding—but I favor more benches where the light is subdued enough not to embarrass the young people in the park," said Chief McQuaid. [United Press Leased Wire.] Seattle, June 18.—The historic merchant steamer Zafiro, which played an important part in the Spanish-American war, is soon to lose her identity in a junk yard, according to a report at the Bremerton navy yard. The vessel is to be sold to a Seattle junk company, whose offer to pay \$3300 for it was the only one received in response to advertisements for bids. The Zafiro is a steel, schooner rigged vessel of 1200 tons displacement and was built at Aberdeen, Scotland, in 1884. She carries a British register.
