DEDICATE OREGON BUILDING

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Seattle, Wash., June 18.—Oregon day at the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition was favored with bright sunshine and cool breezes, to the delight of the hundreds of Oregonians who flocked the grounds to take part in the dedicatory services attending the formal turning over to the exposition of the Oregon state building.

The exercises began in the Oregon building at 11 o'clock this morning, with an address by Hon. C. E. S. Wood, of Portland. The building was then formally tendered the exposition management in a speech by Governor Benson, and President Chilberg delivered the address of acceptance. During the ceremonies music was provided by the administration band, and vocal solos were rendered by John Claire Montell and Miss Alice Juston. The former sang the Toreador's song from "Carmen," and the latter "My Garden of Roses."

In the afternoon there was a reception on the lawn surrounding the Oregon building, at which refreshments were served. Mrs. Governor Benson acted as hostess, and she was assisted by Mrs. J. H. 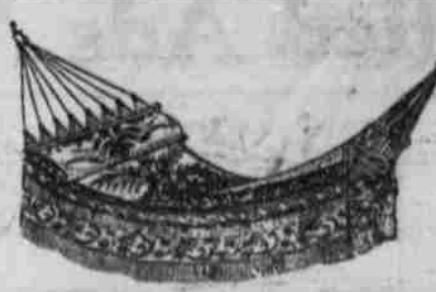
