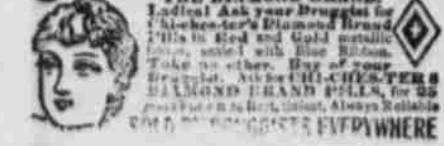

CLEELUM MARSHAL KILLS DESPERADO

Ellensburg, Wash., June 23.—Poses are scouring the mountains in the vicinity of Cle-Elum today for two desperados, who escaped after a third member of the gang had been shot and killed by Marshal Frank Haight, following the robbery of several stores by the trio at Cle-Elum last night. After looting the stores of about \$200, the bandits attempted to hold up the automobile stage which runs between Cle-Elum and Roslyn, but the chauffeur put on full speed and escaped. The officers were notified, and Marshal Haight encountered the robbers in the railroad yard. Two of the men turned and ran, but the third drew a revolver and attempted to shoot the officer. Marshal Haight was too quick for him, however, and sent a bullet through the robber's head, killing him instantly. His two pals escaped. The dead man has not been identified. A search of his body revealed \$200 sewed on the inside of his clothing.

At a coroner's inquest held in Ellensburg, Marshal Haight was exonerated for the killing.

COUNTRY CLUB HOUSE AT TACOMA BURNS

Tacoma, Wash., June 23.—The Country Club building at American Lake, 14 miles from Tacoma, is a mass of ashes today, as the result of a fire which started in the kitchen late last night. The loss is placed at \$15,000, nearly covered by insurance.

Superintendent Quinlan organized the 30 employes into a bucket brigade, and, by hard work, saved the bath house, the boat house and cottages. For a time the entire settlement, with a number of beautiful summer homes, was threatened.
