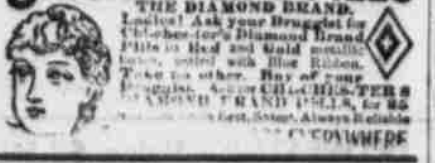

WOMAN SUFFRAGE

CONVENTION TO MEET

Seattle, June 29.—Delegates from every state in the Union will arrive in Seattle on a special train tonight to attend the first annual convention of the American Woman Suffrage Association, which will begin its sessions on Thursday and continue for one week.

The delegates to the convention have been welcomed with enthusiasm at all points along the route, and at Spokane the reception accorded the delegates was on a large scale. Upon the arrival of the train at several towns and cities on route today, Rev. Anna Howard Shaw, national president, and Mrs. Emma Smith Devoe, state president, will deliver short speeches in the cause of equal suffrage and at each of the several stops the party will be joined by other delegates to the convention.

The convention will be called to order by the president, Rev. Anna Howard Shaw. The order of the first day of the convention will be practically a ceremonial. Fraternal greetings and state welcomes will be exchanged, and on Friday morning the regular routine business will be begun.

DYING CONSTABLE

KILLS TRAIN ROBBER

Vancouver, B. C., June 29.—A posse is in hot pursuit today of the man suspected of being one of the four bandits who held up a Canadian Pacific railroad train at Ducks, B. C., June 21, and who, in a revolver duel last night shot and killed Provincial Constable Decker. The partner of the murderer was killed by Decker as the latter lay dying from his wounds.

A pistol duel occurred at Ashcroft while Constable Decker was endeavoring to arrest two of the four men who are supposed to have been implicated in the train robbery. The constable found the men crossing the Thompson river in a rowboat. Upon landing, he commanded them to surrender. Quick as lightning one of the men drew a revolver and fired. Decker fell, mortally wounded, but raising himself on his elbow, the plucky officer sent a bullet through the heart of the companion of the man who had shot him down.

SECRETARY OF NAVY

TO VISIT THE COAST

Taylor returned yesterday from a European tour, and stopped in Boston to attend a session of the board. Secretary of Agriculture Wilson probably will accompany the board.
