**CHERRY DAY AT SEATTLE**

**GROUNDS FLOODED WITH DELICIOUS FRUIT FROM ALL NORTH-WEST**

(United Press Leased Wire)  
Seattle, Wash., July 1.—Today is "Cherry Day" at the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition, and three states, Washington, Oregon and Idaho, flooded the grounds with cherries. Practically everything from the main entrance to the south gate, and even on the "Pay Streak" is illustrative of cherries.

At noon a big parade denoted the beginning of the official reign of the cherry. The pageant, made up of cherry floats, and headed by a band, traversed the grounds, ending at the stadium. Following the parade, a luncheon was had at the New York state building by the executive committee on cherry day, the speakers, commissioners, and special guests. Following the parade, thousands of cherries were distributed in the stadium during the afternoon, and speeches were made in the auditorium in honor of cherry day. A. B. McKinley, executive commissioner of Idaho, presided.

**OREGON ELKS WILL GO TO LOS ANGELES**

Portland, July 1.—Seventy-five elks of Portland have already put their names down on the list of those of the local order who will go to Los Angeles to participate in the coming reunion of the grand lodge. Indications are that at least 200 will leave Portland when the special train pulls out on July 8.

The southern Oregon contingent will be picked up en route, while the delegations from eastern Oregon and Washington will go independently on special cars that may be put through as a second section of the Elks' special. The grand lodge reunion commences July 19.

**Lebanon Will Celebrate.**  
Arrangements are about completed for the best celebration of the national holiday ever held in Linn county. The Lebanon Business Men's League is heading the undertaking of giving the celebration. As every business man in that town is a member of the league and all are working in harmony, the celebration promises to surpass anything of the kind ever attempted there.

This being a novelty for this part of the state, it is attracting wide attention, and promises to bring a large crowd of people to Lebanon. The celebration will take place on Saturday, July 3, with the first events to begin Friday night. The festivities will close Sunday with a big baseball game.

**STOLE SHIPLOAD OF MERCHANDISE**

Vancouver, B. C., July 1.—Charged with making away with a whole ship load of goods obtained under false pretenses from merchants on the Atlantic coast, E. S. Kirkconnell, wanted in New York, is under arrest here awaiting extradition. He was arrested on a farm near Vancouver yesterday. The warrant charges that in the spring of 1908 Kirkconnell, who was master of a New York vessel, and his brother boldly sailed away with a cargo of goods for Honduras. Here the stolen goods were landed and sold. Then began a pursuit, which finally ended in capture. While being brought back to New York, Kirkconnell escaped by leaping from the boat and swimming ashore. Search for the missing man has never been abandoned.  
Kirkconnell is the owner of a fine ranch near Vancouver, and is reputed to be wealthy.
