**CONTESTING FOR THE ALEXANDRA TROPHY**  
Seattle, Wash., July 3.—Over a 12-mile course out of Seattle's harbor the yachts Spirit II, of Seattle, and Alexander, of Vancouver, are contesting today for the most coveted

prize in the Pacific coast sailing race. The Alexander is the defender of the Alexandra trophy, offered in competition by Lieutenant-Governor Dunsmuir, of British Columbia, and the Spirit II, the challenger, will endeavor to wrest from the Canadians the cup they won from the Spirit I last year.

The first race of the best two out of three series started this morning at 10:30 o'clock. The fleet racers began their 12-mile sprint from a line on the West Seattle buoy.

The time limit for the race is five hours. In case neither of the flyers finishes the full course in this time the first of the series will be sailed next Monday afternoon.

Early indications were that the racers would have a good breeze during the whole journey.
