TWELVE MILES LOCATED

Marshall Times: Within the next ten days, the first 12 miles of the Coos Bay and Roseburg division of the Coos Bay and Boise railway will be definitely located. This was the announcement made today by Chief Engineer Haines, who came this afternoon to consult with the officers of the company and look after local matters concerning the line. Mr. Haines is feeling elated over the success of the survey. "We have spent considerable time on the preliminary survey, in order to make certain that we have secured the lowest possible grade and the easiest possible construction," he said. "Unless the preliminary survey is thorough, many thousands of dollars may be added to the cost of construction, and we are working to get the best possible road for the lowest possible cost. "We are working hard to get the survey completed before the rainy season, but we are going through some difficult country. There is a heavy growth of brush, and the amount of slashing that has to be done is a severe handicap. "However, I may say that I am getting a better grade and getting it where the cost of construction will be less than I had expected to be able to do." Mr. Haines is desirous of having a second surveying party put in the field, so that there will be no doubt but that the survey will be completed during good weather.

ONE BRIGHT IS WEDDED TO OTHER

[United Press Leased Wire.] Chicago, July 6.—Miss Beatrice Bright of Livermore, Cal., and Chas. Bright, a postal clerk of Bloomington, Ill., are to be married here tonight. Until Miss Bright arrived in Chicago early this week she never had seen the man she crossed the continent to wed. The romance that will reach a happy culmination tonight was conducted through Uncle Sam's postal channels. Bright one day came upon a letter addressed to his fair namesake in California. He made a memorandum of the name and a few days later sent Miss Bright a card bearing above his name and address the greeting, "Hello, Bee." An answer came within a month, resulting in a correspondence that ended in the young lady's trip to this city.

MARATHON RACE RUN AT TACOMA

[United Press Leased Wire.] Tacoma, July 6.—Two thousand people saw John D. Marsh of Winnipeg, Canada, win the first Marathon race ever run in Tacoma, at Athletic park last night, the runner covering the 26 miles 385 yards in two hours and 49 minutes. Alex Rowan of Vancouver, B. C., came second about two miles behind; William Stanley of San Francisco was a mile back of him and Rinaldo Wilson and Bert Eddington of Tacoma, and Bill Haber of Alaska were still running when the race was called off. Carl Brick of Norway dropped off in the fourth lap and Pete Peters, the South Sea Islander, quit in the eleventh mile. None of the runners, excepting Marsh, kept going all the time. He never stopped after he started and hardly changed his speed until he crossed the line.

HURLED CHUNK OF COAL AT PRESIDENT'S CAR

[United Press Leased Wire.] New York, July 6.—Hurting a chunk of anthracite coal, weighing nearly four pounds through the window of a coach attached to Taft's special train, some unknown miscreant attempted to injure the President last night. The coal was hurled at the train just after it had left New London for New York last night. It crashed through the window of the coach next to that occupied by the presidential party, and was thrown with sufficient force to have killed anyone it happened to strike. Glass was scattered through the car, but fortunately the coach was unoccupied at the time. All of the windows in Taft's coach, the "Mayflower," were closed at the time of the incident, and it is thought that the perpetrator of the outrage either did not know what car the President was riding in or misjudged its position in the train. Detective in the President's body guard made a prompt investigation, but, as far as has been learned, did not discover who hurled the coal. The President left here for Fort Ticonderoga at 7:45 o'clock this morning, the "Mayflower" being attached to a regular train.
